OBSERVATIONS ON THE RELIGIOUS LIFE

We, Peter II, Supreme Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of El Palmar de Troya, *De Cruce Apocalýptica*, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We place Our words in the hands of the Most Holy Virgin Mary, so that She, as Divine Shepherdess and Divine Doctress, guide and teach Us, so that all be to the good pleasure of Her Divine Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, whom We, poor sinner, ardently desire to love and serve with the greatest fidelity, always counting on the help of His grace.

We, Peter II, Pope, taking into account that the basis of our Christian life is the way marked out by Our Lord Jesus Christ, Supreme Model, today analyse the surprising Gospel episode of the cursing of the fig-tree: Jesus felt hungry, and "seeing from afar a fig tree by the road, He went up to see if He could find something on it to eat. But when He came, not finding anything on it but leaves, since it was not the season for figs, He said: 'May fruit never ever grow on you. Never may anyone ever eat fruit from you'; and at once the fig tree withered up." This Gospel passage, which many might pass over as a simple curiosity, or as an unimportant incident, has a content able to turn the world upside down and soften the hardest hearts, if meditated on with interest and deep humility. In this brief text is enclosed the mystery of man's salvation, which depends on his response to God's graces. The fig-tree with the wealth of leaves and capable of bearing fruit, had no fruit at the moment Christ wished, not being the right season of the year. Yet to teach us that we are obliged to yield fruits of virtue at every moment, He displayed His infinite indignation, and cursed it, withering it up from the roots without possibility of ever bearing fruit.

Beloved children of Our Papal Heart: by virtue of the Holy Sacrament of Baptism, you have been planted in the most fruitful garden of Holy Mother Church, founded by Our Lord Jesus Christ, dressed with His shameful sufferings and watered with His Most Precious Blood. In this garden you receive the flow of the Vivifying Sap, capable of producing highly abundant fruit in each of you, with which Christ wishes to sate His ardent hunger for souls, since He died on the Cross earnestly desiring the salvation of all mankind. Hence the tree of your Christian life, being grafted onto Christ, fortified by grace and vivified by the Holy Ghost, has more than sufficient vitality to produce very plentiful and delicious fruits of virtue,





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




always counting on generous response to divine action. As you can see in the Gospel passage, God's demands are categorical, He does not admit deceptive fruitfulness. The tree of the spiritual life does not consist of branches with dense foliage alone, with an apparent fruitfulness bereft of fruit, for though it appears very beautiful and pleasant in the sight of men, it is not so with God, since the tree of the spiritual life has been planted to give abundant fruits of virtue, and if it remains barren, that is abominable in the eyes of the Creator. He cannot be deceived nor seduced with fantasies and appearances. God Our Lord penetrates souls, sounds out hearts, scrutinizes thoughts, weighs and measures deeds with exact reckoning, and knows our diligence or negligence in our doings perfectly well. Sooner or later the tree of the Christian life, for lack of response to grace, can even dry up to the deepest roots, and become separated from the leafy garden of the Church, without possibility of recovering her vitality and freshness, unless by being planted again through sincere repentance. Accordingly, beloved children, supernatural fruitfulness should be permanent, as is inferred from the Gospel passage, and not limited to a time or season of life. Christ, as Divine Sower of the good seed, can come at any moment, when least expected, to call us to account and gather His harvest. Alas for the fruitless tree! It will be cast eternally into the infernal abyss of its iniquitous fruitlessness.

O beloved children of Our Priestly Soul! We live in times when the Holy Ark of the Church sails amidst an abominable and tempestuous flood promoted by the rampant general apostasy. The turbulent waters of heresy and corruption are discharging their abomination upon the universe, and have reached the topmost peaks, covering everything. In the midst of this furious swell, the true Church of Christ, the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian, sails on unscathed, guided by Us, Universal Shepherd, under the protection of her Divine Founder, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and with the Succour of His Most Holy Mother, the Virgin Mary. This flood of corruption on a universal scale is the most terrible scourge which mankind has suffered up till now. Mankind lives at Satan's mercy, wallowing about in the mud of iniquity. What greater chastisement can man have than to find himself deprived of God's friendship and become the object of his Holy and Infinite Wrath! For mark that God Our Lord, infinite Goodness and Love, necessarily loves good and hates evil, so that He infinitely hates Satan, father of evil, and all his henchmen. This hatred extends as well to all those in mortal sin, because of the infinite malice sin implies, and because while man remains in that lamentable state he is guilty of Hell; though, true enough, in His infinite mercy, God wishes to save him, and offers him the necessary means. Given this, you can form some idea of the divine curse that now weighs upon corrupt mankind. This universal flood of heresy and of sin in all its species and degrees of malice, by divine permission, is the greatest chastisement that has befallen the universe up till now, since it is far superior to any physical deathtoll, however great. In turn, this flood of human perversity unceasingly calls out for the flood of exterminating fire that will fall upon the earth. Apostle Saint Paul, in his letter to the Hebrews, says that "God's wrath is like a devouring fire."

We, Peter II, Vicar of Christ, exhort all Palmarian faithful evermore to stay firm in Peter's Barque in this crucial hour. If unfortunately you were to fall outside of her, it would be very hard for you to make your way back after having been submerged in the infernal swell which furiously encircles and lashes her. Look, beloved children, when someone by lack of response to grace incurs apostasy, he shuts behind him the gates of the Ark of Salvation; and then We, by virtue of the Supreme Power received from Christ, fasten the door with a heavy bolt, and at the same time hermetically seal up all the windows, so that no foul air gets in, and thus those who remain inside are better protected against any kind of diabolic influence





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


coming from outside. Either inside Peter's Barque or outside of her. Those who abandon her have no right to pry, even through the windows, and see what happens inside. They have only the option of returning to the bosom of Holy Mother Church sincerely repentant and fulfilling the conditions imposed upon them; or to stay outside with the gravest risk of eternal damnation. Every day We ask for the conversion of sinners. Do so yourselves as well.

Beloved children, all: We, Peter II, again insist on the strict obligation of faithfully fulfilling the Commandments of the Holy Law of God and of Holy Mother Church. For this it is absolutely necessary ever to bear in mind the norms in the Holy Palmarian-Catechism, digest of Christian life, a book you should frequently peruse so as to have a clear knowledge of its content of Faith and Morals, of the malice of sin and of the way to act against Satan's temptations, the seductions of the world and the concupiscences of the flesh. Beloved children, there is no question in you of invincible ignorance, since you are in possession of the necessary means to differentiate rightly between what is forbidden and what is allowed. Read the Holy Palmarian Catechism frequently and you will receive light and strength to keep to the divine guidelines. The reading and fulfilment of God's Law will flood your souls with heavenly peace and jubilee. The Holy Prophet David, in one of his psalms, gives testimony of this when he says: "The commandments of the Lord are upright and gladden hearts. The precept of the Lord is luminous and enlightens consciences." See as well what God says in the Book of Proverbs: "My child, do not forget My Holy Law, and keep My Commandments in your heart, because they will lade you with peace on earth and glory in eternal life." We have come to know that some of you do not correctly fulfil what is laid down in the Third Commandment of the Law of God on Sunday rest. This commandment tells us to sanctify Holydays. This implies not only the obligation to hear the Holy Masses prescribed by the Church, but also to abstain from doing work without grave need. In the Palmarian Catechism the work forbidden or permitted on Sundays and other Holydays is listed. Read with attention, and if there is something you do not understand well, ask the Palmarian Bishops, and they will be sure to guide you. How many out of neglect, apathy or carelessness in examining the Holy Catechism fail to comply with grave precepts or do not fulfil them with the requirements necessary! Those who act thus, besides sinning mortally, scandalize those who by some circumstance happen to observe them, which implies a further malice of sin. Consequently you are strictly obliged to know as best you can the norms given by God and by the Church in order to fulfil them with promptness and integrity. You are obliged to avoid any kind of offence to God, and should abstain from all appearance of evil, as Apostle Saint Paul teaches.

O beloved faithful! Keep your doors always shut to the reigning doctrinal and moral contamination. We are now referring to the doors of the soul, the doors of the heart, and the doors of the bodily senses which are in turn like the soul's windows. It is needful that all these doors be always kept hermetically closed to the ferocious roars of the world's corruption. And We say ferocious roars because, in these Apocalyptic Times, you find yourselves compelled to live in the midst of a thundering bestiality, ever exposed to the voracious bites of the wild beasts. It is absolutely necessary that you keep custody of your senses so as not to see things that easily seduce and can induce you to sin, so as not to hear obscenities, blasphemies and blather issuing from so many unclean tongues, so as not to smell the stench issuing from the multitude of corrupt walking cadavers who people the cities, so as not to taste the illicit delicacies placed within man's reach, and so as not to touch what can burn you with disastrous eternal consequences. With the careful custody of bodily senses, the castle of the soul will be more impregnable. The





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


senses are like the windows of the soul, and if they open to the world's corruption, it will penetrate inside and end up staining and contaminating her. O beloved children! If you could at least glimpse the reality of a soul in the state of grace, you would perhaps never sin, so as not to lose the loftiest grandeur enclosed within her. The soul in the state of grace is, as you know, shrine and tabernacle of the Most Blessed Trinity. In the soul in the state of grace, the plenitude of the intratrinitary life acts, with all the unfathomable divine mysteries. The soul, by virtue of the Trinitary indwelling, is constantly engendered by the Father in the supernatural life, the Father and Son give her to share in Their mutual love, which is the Holy Ghost, and in short give her to share in divine life itself on raising her up to the Hypostatic Order. The soul in the state of grace enshrines in herself all the Sacrosanct Mysteries which constitute the essential glory and accidental glory of Eternal Blessedness.

We, Peter II, Pope, again summon all Palmarian faithful to keep too the doors of their houses very well closed. Palmarian homes are the prolongation of God's Church, and in them blessed purity, holy discipline, perfect order and punctilious godliness are to reign. In this way the members of the household find at home the spirituality they lack on the streets and in workplaces. Shut tight the doors of your houses, the doors of your porches, the gates of your gardens, the doors of your cars, so that no one indecent enter inside and stain the sanctity of the Christian home. Keep close watch, beloved children, for those of the world do not usually respect your rights as Palmarian Catholics, and they can catch you unawares, and then it will be more difficult to react in time for lack of forcefulness, and easy cowardly to give way. There can be nothing in your homes that profane the sanctity which should reign within them. You already know the norms given by the Church in this respect. Be valiant!

Dearest children of Our Papal Heart: in these Apocalyptic Times, the true Church of Christ, the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian, in the silent retreat of the Mystical Desert of El Palmar de Troya, appears unknown, unnoticed, not because she has not given, and still gives, sufficient testimony to the Truth, but because the lovers of this world are opposed to acknowledging her. Many know that to acknowledge the Catholic Palmarian Faith and Morals entails grave commitments of all kinds, great renunciations, such as to exchange a life of dissipation, wrong beliefs and pagan morals for an imitation of Christ thoroughly faithful to the Church's norms. But we Palmarians, in the solitude of the desert, are the torches of mankind. We live in the world, but not according to the world nor with the world, and that is the best endorsement of our authenticity. The life of the Palmarian is in some measure that of a hermit, by which We do not deny that he be in turn sociable and apostolic. To live as true Christians in the midst of a crowded corrupt society, without allowing evil to influence, is a great apostolate, that of the silent and patient exercise of virtue, that of good example through fulfilment of religious and professional duties. Look, dearest children, owing to Palmarian disciplinary norms, very necessary so as not to be contaminated by the world, you find yourselves obliged to do without many things, including relatives and friends, to communicate with the required restrictions, to speak only that strictly necessary, to live practically alone, which helps you to be ever more united to the Sacred Family of Nazareth, Jesus, Mary and Joseph and, in imitation of them, to live a more or less retired life, until the moment comes for the Church to leave the Mystical Desert of El Palmar, to display before the world in an apotheosic manner the resplendence of the glory mysteriously enclosed in this blessed portion of earth. You are preparing yourselves with your life of austerity and silent observance of the divine will for the great events which are to come. Many of this world's lovers, observing your fidelity to God's Law and the Palmarian Church's dispositions, treat you as





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





if you were strange people, unsociable and unbalanced, but at the same time, in their interior, they will have no option but to recognize you as upright and sensate individuals; for good example gives out a perfume which penetrates to the depths of souls and moves even the loftiest mountains. It is the perfume of the Blood which Christ poured out, unmistakeable and imperious. How many souls, countless souls, have already been saved at particular judgement moved by the good examples they have observed in your lives! That then is the Palmarian Church of the patient and silent apostolate. The mysterious seed which springs up by itself in the Gospel parable. Be of good cheer, beloved children. Onwards. Jesus demands that you raise up His Cross valiantly, which means being crucified and dying on it, until the hour of glorious resurrection comes for those who remain faithful to the graces received from God.

We, Peter II, believe it very profitable to address the Friars and Nuns of our Order of Carmelites of the Holy Face in Company of Jesus and Mary. The religious life, dearest children, is the complete commitment, in soul and body, to God's service, by way of the fulfilment of the Holy Vows of Obedience, Poverty and Chastity, and by way of the observance of the Holy Rules established by our Most Holy Father Founder Pope Saint Gregory XVII. These Holy Rules are a very simple digest of the grand edifice of the religious life. By way of their exact observance, the members of the Order go about sanctifying themselves little by little, and are able to reach very high degrees of sanctity. The fulfilment of the Holy Rules, though the norms appear simple and elemental, implies a constant and heroic effort, since they have to be integrally fulfilled, with great zeal and perfection. The religious life implies loving and serving God, fulfilling the Holy Rules with complete fidelity. The good religious is in the monastery to love Our Lord and God and his brethren in Religion generously. This love has to consist in virtuous acts. Words by themselves, if unaccompanied by the exercise of true charity, are quite empty, and those who content themselves with mere outward appearances incur the sentence recalled by Christ in the Gospel: "This people honours Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me". True love, therefore, is intimately united to God's and our brethren's service, with the strictest obedience. This service has to be wholehearted, generous, detached, sacrificed, and this is incompatible with lukewarmness, insubordination, selfishness, negligence and laziness. The life of the true religious has to be transparent, loyal, without duplicity, without guile and without dissimulation. The good religious always acts with uprightness of conscience and proceeds with the greatest nobility. Look, dear children, Christ and Mary zealously watch over those who have consecrated themselves to Them. Although there be things which pass unnoticed by the monastery Superior, limited as he is in his person, Christ and Mary keep them very much in mind, and keep an account of the actions of everyone with rigorous exactness, though with utmost patience. But when they see a Friar or Nun falsifying religious life over and over again, without possible amendment, sooner or later they dispense with the rotten apple. The greatest evil that can befall a monastery is lukewarmness, since it attacks the very foundations of religious life. Look, beloved children in religion, at what Christ says to the lukewarm in the Apocalypse: "As you act lukewarmly, however, I will spew you out of My mouth, since by your mediocrity and indifference in the exercise of virtue you are loathsome in My eyes; lukewarmness implying selfish and arrogant conformity, owing to the scorning of many of the graces which I give you in order that you attain to salvation." The good religious is distinguished by his assiduous spirit of prayer, by his unblemished spirit of penance, by his prompt and submissive obedience, by his punctiliousness at any request. The good religious ought to help his brethren and sacrifice himself for them; he ought to be always ready to carry out any task commended to him, generously and







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painstakingly, without encumbering others with the burden that is his to bear, and trying to lighten the burdens of others within holy observance. Beware! Beware of false charity, which can distort and even destroy the true life of conventual obedience. The good religious is highly obedient to his Superior, always taking into account that he represents Christ in the community and that by way of his orders he fulfils God's will. The good religious is deeply humble, prudent on speaking, faithful to observe the silence of the cloister; he does not answer back, nor does he tell tales, nor does he grouse. Beware! Beware of false sicknesses, which cause the slackening of conventual discipline. But attend the truly sick well, so that they lack nothing necessary. The good religious, though with his imperfections and miseries, tries with all his strength to be a model of every virtue, to please God and edify his brethren with his exemplary life, so that the monastery ever breathes holiness. Reflect, Friars and Nuns, on these poor words of Ours, Superior General of the Order, and force yourselves to put them into practice, since for this purpose you entered the monastery. We ask you: Why did you enter the religious life? And your reply should be: To serve God generously! Well then, onward all, to serve God with wholehearted commitment and submission to His divine will, ever obedient to the orders of the Superior who represents Him and who wants you to attain sanctity.

We, Peter II, Pope, earnestly wish Our words on the religious life to be borne very much in mind by the lay faithful, above all by those who are capable of consecrating themselves to God and serving Him within the monastery. We insist once again that those who feel some attraction to the religious life should take the decisive step, always bearing in mind that this is a State of Perfection and, as such, way of the cross, though with its spiritual compensations. The peace with which the good Friar and the good Nun live, far surpasses any human consolation or satisfaction. It is God Himself who gives his consecrated to share, in the measure possible in this world, in His own infinite peace and happiness, though accompanied by bitter penances and deep sufferings. Those who suffer patiently for Christ in the religious life are recompensed here with the sweetness of His divine balsam, and will be recompensed hereafter with the ineffable happiness of Eternal Blessedness and in very lofty degree.



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


So, when in the Marian hymn you say "Salve Madre! En la tierra de tus amores ..." ("In the land of your tender love..."), you are always referring to this blessed plot of land of the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, where Mary reigns over the hearts of yourselves, the children who form the true flock of Our Lord Jesus Christ, and who sincerely love Her who is Mother of that flock or Holy Church. You, beloved children, are an integral part of this blessed land, and therefore you are spiritually the land of Mary's tender love. The Land of Mary Most Holy extends, then, to your hearts and to your families and to your Palmarian homes, and therefore to all those children who love Her with hearts true, deep and sincere. But the love of our Most Holy Mother the Virgin Mary does not consist only in external manifestations or mere appearances. In order to be true, it must be accompanied by the profession of the Palmarian Catholic Faith, by the exercise of Christian virtues, of charity; in a word, by unconditional submission to the True Church and the Vicar of Christ who shepherds Her. The Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya is your Holy Land, Palmarian faithful, and the Cathedral-Basilica erected there is your true Home, the home of all you who live united by the supernatural ties of Faith and Grace, which are abysmally superior to ties of blood. Supernatural family life, owing to its sublime and celestial link, is in this life the maximum representation of the family life

See, dearest faithful: you still live as pilgrims in a homeland turned into a sorry exile because of original sin. And as the only bearers of True Light that you are, the children of darkness consider you in this world as outsiders, and effectively you are, as your true homeland is in Heaven, Eternal Blessedness, where Our Lord God awaits you to participate in His glory forever, for all eternity!, in company with the vast number of the Blessed. That is Holy Church glorified, the Heavenly Jerusalem. In her, as the Apocalypse says, "there will never be any evil." And "those who dwell therein will serve faithfully contemplating the Divine Essence face to face. Neither will there be night, nor will they need light of human making, nor light of sun, as the Triune Lord God Himself will illuminate them and reign with them for ever and ever." Aspire ardently, beloved children, to be one day citizens of the Heavenly Homeland for all eternity. Where you live now is a bitter thoroughfare, an impoverished city surrounded by enemies, a wilderness full of thorns and countless afflictions, "a bad night in a bad inn" as the Eminent Reformatrix of Carmel Saint Teresa of Jesus said. If you persevere in virtue you will soon be dwellers of Heaven, the Immortal Homeland. Life in this world seems long, but it is shorter than one thinks. It passes quickly. What are even a hundred years of life compared to the happiness of an eternity without end? The pains of this world are nothing if at the end you save your soul. And on the contrary, as Christ Himself says: "For what shall it profit a man if he gain the whole world and then suffer the loss of his soul?" Think of those unfortunates who have already spent centuries in Hell, including millennia, with no possible way out, always the same and forever. Of what use were the joys and other worldly pleasures, luxury and wealth, flattery and vainglory...! All has passed and all will continue to pass in this worldly life. What will never end is the eternal misfortune of those who plunge into the infernal abyss. We understand that all of this is known to you, but good and profitable it is to meditate on it. Death is like a thief in the night who can catch by surprise when least expected. Death does not respect age or state of man. Sooner or later it comes to everyone, and woe to those who are not duly prepared to meet it.

We, Peter II, shall speak briefly about doctors, medicines and the sick. In conformity with what is established in Holy Palmarian Morals, when a Palmarian is ill, he has the duty, under pain of mortal sin, to obtain treatment from officially recognised doctors. In this regard, in the book of Ecclesiasticus, the Holy

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Ghost exhorts us, saying: "Honour the doctor who treats you uprightly, because the Most High has placed him to care for the health of your body; because medicine comes from God. The Most High gave men medical knowledge so that they might honour Him with the wonderful effects that proceed therefrom: and therefore the divine will is that men know the virtue and efficacy of medicines for curing illnesses; since with them the doctor gives health to the body and relieves pain, and the pharmacist elaborates them so that God's creatures may not perish at every illness. Child, in your sickness send for the doctor, as the Lord has placed him as guardian over your health, and do not send him away, since you need him." It has come to Our knowledge that a considerable proportion of Germanspeaking Palmarian faithful have stored away great quantities of herbal medicines which, according to several doctors who elaborate and propagate them, cure all infirmities. All that has aroused among the faithful a kind of collective obsession, since they continually speak only of those medicines and their effects, with the consequent depreciation, explicit or implicit, of classical pharmaceutical products. Those medicines were accompanied by books and other publications, where in an underhand, pseudo-scientific and restrictive way, medicines sold in pharmacies are discredited, considered as outright poison. From this is deduced open opposition to officially recognized doctors, including to hospitals themselves, according to the conclusions We have reached after examining the books that have come into Our hands. Moreover, the taking of those medicines is accompanied at times by certain preparatives which to Our understanding are superstitious. These doctors, in their theories pervaded by rationalism and pantheism, consider classical medicines as hostile to health, which opposes the teaching of the Church. It is lamentable that many of you have let yourselves be so easily seduced by such theories. Look, idolatry manifests itself in different ways, according to the idol adored, which can even be medicines themselves. Therefore, that exaggerated accumulation of medicines in Palmarian homes is worship of idolatry, and a great lack of trust in God's providence, who foresees all and makes provision so that you lack nothing.

We, as zealous watchman, have ordered, under pain of excommunication reserved to Us, that faithful who possess those medicines should hand them over to the Church immediately, together with the books and other publications, to be destroyed. So, those who still possess them are obliged to hand them over without any delay to the Missionary Bishop. Take great care, beloved children, least Satan deceive you, confound you and draw you away with him! You have been swindled by the theories of those doctors in such wise that you should give thanks to God that We have intervened in time. When the demon does not achieve his perverse aims in one way, he tries another. Take great care! They set a trap for you with dire spiritual consequences. We are not opposed to medicines sold by herbalists authorized by state health organizations, as long as they are not opposed to the dispositions of the Church. But We cannot permit that Palmarian faithful buy those herbalist products with the intention of doing without the medicines sold in other pharmacies considering them harmful to health. That is a tremendous aberration! All medical science that is not opposed to God the Creator has been inspired by Him for the good of our bodily health. Qualified doctors have the mission of prescribing, after due examination, those medicines appropriate for each infirmity. We know that there are medicines which require no medical prescription; yet even then those who buy them should be very prudent. See, beloved children: just as Priests are instruments of God for the health of souls, doctors are instruments of God for the health of bodies, and the means are the treatments they conscientiously recommend, which usually include medicines. Never dare to be your own doctor. This implies contempt of those to





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
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whom, according to the divine plan, the vigilance and care of corporal health pertains. Do not be reluctant to go to officially recognised doctors when you have real need. Nevertheless, make sure that your doctors are upright and of good repute, and if one should give opinions or prescribe anything contrary to the dispositions of the Palmarian Church, you are then obliged to reject it outright, and look elsewhere for a suitable doctor. Beware, beware of faith-healers and other false doctors! You already know it is forbidden to go to them under pain of excommunication reserved to Us. Beware, beware of caprices! We know that some faithful, trying to cure themselves, have used superstitious means. That is quite inadmissible in a true child of the Church.

Dearly beloved children: We, as most earnest guardian of souls, exhort you with yet greater insistence to frequent Holy Mass and the reception of the Holy Sacraments as often you can. Moreover, as you know, whenever the Priest celebrates in the Palmarian Chapel to which you belong, it is obligatory to assist at Holy Masses on Sundays and other days of obligation, unless there is grave impediment. Also, when unable to do so on a Sunday or other Holyday of Obligation, there is the duty to assist on some other day of the week, when there is the opportunity, to comply with the duty of Sunday and other Holydays of Obligation. You possess the immense blessing, the exceptional privilege to have at your disposition these supernatural means necessary for salvation. Outside of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, priests lack the power to exercise validly any act of the priestly ministry. The Holy Ghost poured out in the Deific Blood of Christ is the Uncreated Soul of one single Church, the true one, so that He could never be a guest of souls not belonging to Christ's Mystical Body supernaturalized and vivified by the Most Divine Paraclete. In order to sanctify yourselves more and more each day, it is necessary to be fortified by the means Christ has given to His Church, the fundamentals of which are, We repeat, Holy Mass and the Sacraments. We understand that not all Palmarian faithful have them at their disposition every day, since each Missionary Bishop has to attend different Palmarian Chapels in his respective diocese. So, when the Minister of the Lord visits you in your Chapel, always assist at Sacred Worship, making the most of the supernatural benefits. In the Palmarian dioceses of Europe the distances are shorter, and often you have more than sufficient time to go in your vehicles to the Chapels where the Missionary Bishop is. Never let laziness prevent you. Always assist when you can. Make use of the opportunities Our Lord God places within your reach. You need to be strengthened as much as possible to face up to the onslaughts of Satan, the world and the flesh, especially in this hour of the powers of darkness. Be ever more obedient to the dispositions of Holy Church. Struggle on firmly so as not to transgress them, seeing that there are faithful who appear not to take the grievousness of excommunications very seriously, as they incur in them with certain reiteration. Beware of human considerations! Always keep in mind the words of Christ: "Whoever confesses Me before men, I too will confess him before My Father who is in Heaven. And whoever denies Me before men, I too will deny him before My Father who is in Heaven." Whoever does not give good testimony of the Church before men, is denying Christ Himself, her Founder. Be wary of cowardliness. You are obliged to give testimony of the Truth at every moment, as you are children of the True Church.

Mark, beloved Palmarian faithful: <u>freemasonry in its tenebrous plans</u> to exclude all divine moral order, and establish a purely secular morality independent of God and Catholic Morality, and therefore rational, personal and based on libertinage, has concentrated its greatest efforts on nullifying the true sense of the idea





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


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of the family, this being the fundamental nucleus of society. Once the family has been corrupted, society is plunged into a world of iniquity. Freemasonry and its multiple hangers-on have been gradually eroding the value of authority and family unity in marriage, inculcating in parents an irresponsible attitude towards their duties in the home and impelling children to insubordination. In this manner, present-day family society is a complete chaos. In a very large percentage of cases, the parents are those principally to blame for family aberrations. The breaching of marriage duties, conjugal infidelity, accursed divorces, and in general the corruption of husbands and wives, who are those most bound to give good example in the bosom of the family, have opened the way for children to act according to their fancies and libertine promptings. The mentality of married people, apart from exceptions, today tends mostly to comfort, egoism, well-being and indifference to duty. The father, head of the family and chiefly responsible, in many cases forgoes his authority and duties before his wife and children, and solely minds his own personal interests and pleasures. The wife, heart of the family, in the same manner mostly minds her vain womanly cravings, so-called women's liberation and comforts, rather than her duties as wife and mother. The immense majority of marriages now, in their intimate relations, disregard the unavoidable duty of procreation, considering married life as a union for pleasure; when by divine institution, the principal end of marriage is the procreation of children, which neither man nor woman has power to impede, or put a limit to their number, as married people are gravely obliged to have as many children as God wishes to send them. In the countries which presume to be more civilized, the family birth rate is today very low, almost zero, which is abominable in the eyes of the Creator. Parents abstain from having children to live a carefree life of pleasure. Moreover, every day more contraceptive means appear, manufactured by laboratories of iniquity. These means are backed up by impious laws and placed within easy reach of all. Furthermore, every day there are more abortive means, some of the simplest use and legally authorized.

How many married mothers shun matrimonial fertility and dedicate themselves to unnecessary occupations, including those improper to their sex! They are not willing to bear the discomforts of pregnancy and giving birth, or the sacrifices involved in caring for children. Everywhere the role of the working woman is amplified, and she often fills jobs that neither correspond to her nor are necessary to her, and yet the children she may have are placed in the care of strange hands. Thus many women have the way wide open for politicking and other unnecessary commitments, abandoning their duties as wives and mothers. Yet they are unhappy because they are unable to commandeer more posts and be equal to men in everything. Nonetheless there are many married women with children who, because of adverse circumstances, find themselves forced to work to keep their home going, as they have no other means of income, or what they have is quite insufficient for the family's upkeep. This is quite justified being wholly necessary. Note that now they frequently employ the hateful term "male chauvinist", which they disparagingly apply to men who maintain a non-conformist attitude with regard to the demands of the opposite sex in many things, when more than a few men are defending their manly dignity in the face of the abusive exactions by a good number of women. To women who act thus the term "female chauvinist" applies, since they are trying to strip men of the rights inherent in the male sex, and monopolize them. Lamentably, in these times, if the level of corruption in men is very high, the level of corruption in women has taken unsuspected conduits and heights. Today the immense majority of women, by their comportment, manners and clothing, are vulgar, anti-feminine, brazen and provocative. Returning to the subject of marriages, which here occupies Us, you can understand how society





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


is in general when its essential nucleus, which is the family, is utterly corrupt in the majority of cases. Because of laxity in married life, homes as well have become truly glacial abodes. Parents hardly ever talk with their children. Mothers in the past, by their complete dedication to the family, were those who generally looked after the children and infused family warmth into them. But today a very high percentage of mothers spend little time at home, instead employ themselves in unnecessary activities, even improper and degrading ones. At the present time, many of them work to live more freely with more comforts, and all to the detriment of their duties towards the children. What happens then? The children act towards their parents in the same manner. As they see the bad example of their progenitors: their selfish attitudes, their indifference to family problems, their coldness in their dealings and other attitudes opposed to the good order and uprightness that ought to prevail in the home, they rebel against parental authority from the earliest years, and parents feel incapable of correcting them because they have lost their credit and legitimate standing; and children abandon home at the first opportunity, to live according to the licence they acquired in the bosom of the family. With all that has been said, we do not deny that many times villainous and ungrateful children have come from conscientious families. But then that is another question.

Observe, today much is spoken of the rights of minors. Previously, such rights were contained in parent-child relations, and always under the concept of obedience and submission of children to their parents until they reached the age of emancipation, when parents became free of the obligation to maintain and educate them. This subjection of children to their parents was backed up by the same laws which guaranteed parental authority. In this way parents had sufficient authority to educate their children according to their conscientious criteria, which implied the imposition of corrections and limitations necessary for a good upbringing. Today, lamentably, in defence of the rights of minors, they often go to the extreme of tying those parents hand and foot who desire to give a good upbringing to their children, especially if parents observe in their children a certain tendency to insubordination to parental authority. Parents many times find themselves restricted in the face of the fear of certain laws more favourable to the opinion of the child than to the upright exercise of parental authority. Children know it, since in schools, in the communications media, and in the continuous bluster of so-called child-defence officers, they instil in their own way the child's rights at home; and when parents justly reprimand, many children rebel, and some even threaten to denounce their parents to the civil authorities. We do not deny that there are also many perverse and vicious parents who unjustly illtreat under-age children, and in those cases what is rightly established for the protection of minors should be applied with all speed and efficacy.

Beloved children: You, Palmarian married couples, comport yourselves irreproachably. Palmarian married couples, you know very well your obligations as spouses and parents. Never hold back from giving to God the children He sees fit to grant you! Never put any limit on your procreating duties, so as not to fall into divine malediction! Be ever most generous, however many privations and sufferings your marriage fertility may cause you. Always maintain due order in your homes and let cheerfulness and sanctity be breathed in them. Palmarian parents must never yield their authority in the face of undue demands by their children, who must be painstakingly brought up as Christians, as the apple they are of your eye. Observe, it is of the utmost importance that you educate your children in conformity with the exigencies of Palmarian Doctrine and Morals. This is a grave obligation before God and before the Church. Correct them and punish them when necessary without fear and as often as they need! Before God it is a duty of justice and charity of parents






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
towards their children. Watch over them. Do not permit them to dishonour your homes, which are a prolongation of God's Temple. Failing to do so, you will have to render the strictest account to God. Always give them good example. They must never lack home warmth, so that they feel content there. Palmarian parents, you are also obliged to provide sustenance for your children, the instruction necessary and a suitable trade so that later on they have a satisfactory future and are able to face up to the demands of life and form their own Christian home if they so desire. Palmarian parents and children, endeavour to make the family that you form identify itself as much as possible with the Holy Family of Nazareth, the most perfect prototype of married society. Meditate on the irreproachable conduct of Jesus, Mary and Joseph in the Holy Gospel, and the complete submission of the Three to the plans of the Eternal Father. You who are children of the family, learn from the most exemplary behaviour of Jesus in the bosom of the family, Who being the Son of God Himself was submissive and obedient to his parents Mary and Joseph. You who are wives, learn from the most exemplary behaviour of Mary who, being Mother of God, subjected herself submissively to her most chaste spouse, besides amorously looking after the home. You who are husbands, learn from the most exemplary behaviour of Joseph, who knew admirably how to wield the maximum authority corresponding to him in the bosom of the Holy Family, zealously protecting his Son and Wife.

We, Peter II, conclude this Twelfth Apostolic Letter speaking concisely on the most important matter of courtship. We shall limit Ourself to presenting the most essential teachings contained in Holy Palmarian Morals. As you know, beloved children, courtship between a Palmarian man and a non-Palmarian woman, or between a Palmarian woman and a non-Palmarian man is strictly forbidden under pain of excommunication reserved to Us, since courtship in such circumstances is not the way to attain the grace of the Holy Sacrament of Matrimony. Palmarians should, therefore, avoid any friendship with non-Palmarians that, without becoming exactly courtship, involves an intimacy that could be the first step to courtship, given the weakness of the flesh and the astuteness of the devil. Regarding prudence in the election of the person one wishes to marry, principally spiritual virtues, and natural and acquired qualities, should be taken into consideration; and above all authentic Palmarian life, which guarantees the other qualities. Before an issue of such importance, the person wishing to marry should ask God for the right partner, and should ask advice too from the Confessor; and heed the wise, prudent and Christian counsels of his or her own parents.

Preparation for the state of matrimony must be by way of virtuous and Christian courtship. Without this preparation it is difficult to fulfil the grave obligations of this state and bear patiently the cross of marriage. Courtship is a period of preparation in which a man and a woman, through an honourable, virtuous and Christian relationship, conveniently prepare themselves to fulfil the grave obligations of the married state which they hope to enter in the future. The period of courtship, then, is of great importance for those who feel the vocation to marry. Throughout this period of preparation for marriage, the courting couple, with due respect and honour, should discuss the issues that concern their future marriage with sufficient confidence and sincerity to permit them to know one another. The couple therefore, are even obliged, under pain of mortal sin, to inform each other before marriage if any known internal defect exists that might bring disagreeable or including disastrous consequences in their relations after marriage; especially if the defect be an obstacle to the fecundity of Marriage.

We, Peter II, hope for the maximum affluence of pilgrim faithful at El Palmar for the forthcoming 12th of October. The solemn worship to be celebrated, God willing, in the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned





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Mother of Palmar will be in the following order: At 1 am there will be a turn of Holy Masses on the High Altar and on other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Penitential Rosary; at 10 am the Most Solemn Pontifical Mass will take place with the recital of the Holy Trisagion; at six in the evening a turn of Holy Masses on the High Altar and all other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Way of the Cross. Day and night there will be turns of Holy Masses as well, both on the High Altar and on other Altars. At 9 at night will take place the Most Solemn Procession with the Holy Face of Our Lord Jesus Christ and the Sacred Image of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar.



We, Peter II, Supreme Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of El Palmar de Troya, *de Cruce Apocalyptica*, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We, by means of the present Apostolic Letter, call all the faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church to come on pilgrimage to this Sacred Place in order to be present at the solemn worship to be celebrated, God-willing, in the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar on the occasion of New Year's Eve 2006 and New Year's Day 2007.

We ardently desire that all Palmarian faithful come on pilgrimage to the Holy Apostolic See of the Church to make reparation to Our Lord and God and to His Most Holy Mother the Virgin Mary for the innumerable offences They receive throughout the world, above all on New Year's Eve, when Satan more than ever unleashes all his infernal wiles so that he be adored yet more by those who serve him faithfully. You, beloved children, as true servants that you are of Christ, are obliged to counteract man's ingratitude towards his God and Creator by acts of reparation, by prayer and penance, by generous commitment to God's and the Church's service.

We earnestly desire that Our words penetrate once more into the depths of your souls, and that in them they take life, so that Our Lord and God, One and Three, be ever praised and glorified by Our teachings and your good deeds. Let your hearts be beacons from which true love of God shines out, and which give trustworthy testimony before the world of the Christian charity which should always beam forth from those who possess the Divine Gifts by virtue of the indwelling in them of the Great Supernatural Gift, Who is the Holy Ghost, Uncreated Soul of the Church, Vivifying Guest of those souls incorporated into Christ's Mystical Body: today the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, the one fold of salvation. We require that you be ever united to Christ and Mary, and so be soil supernaturally dressed and fertile.

Beloved children of Our papal heart: the world, imitating Satan, maintains a rebellious and defiant posture with respect to Holy Divine Law. As Apostle Saint Paul says, the spirit of Satan is the spirit that dominates in all rebel





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



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men. Lucifer, that cursed fallen angel, was the first to rebel against the Creator and His divine plans on the day of Universal Creation, saying with incredible pride and disdain: "We shall not serve Him". He was the first to try and oust God from His Immovable and Most August Throne, proposing to be equal to his Almighty Creator, drawing many other angels to countenance his rebellion against divine authority. So, dear children, in souls rebellious against God and His Holy Law, the spirit of Satan dominates. Today, villainous men not only do without God, but they dare to supplant His Supreme Authority. The rebellious spirit of Satan has wholly mastered this apostate and pagan world. On all sides dogged defiance of God and His divine commandments is to be observed. All is permeated with the stench of sin, in its multiple forms and perversity. On all sides Infinite Divine Mercy is flouted, and the Holy Anger of the Infinitely Just One is aroused. The Most Precious Saving Blood poured out by Christ on Calvary is trodden underfoot and sullied, with uncontrollable frenzy by those who love vice and disdain virtue, spread error and belie truth, proclaim Satan's might and reject God's and His Church's authority. But God will pour out His anger and His indignation upon those rebels who do not yield before the truth and who embrace injustice, as Saint Paul also teaches. Just as Lucifer for his pride was cast into Hell, those who second him will also be cast into the darkness of the eternal abyss, if they do not set aside their evil purpose and humble themselves before their God and Creator.

Beloved children: times of constant struggle are those in which we live. Every day our battle against evil is and will be fiercer. Satan's power, now as Antichrist, his dominion over the world increasing, will not be reduced until he once more be temporarily enchained at the Great Apparition of the Most Holy Virgin Mary in the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya. We are living in a very advanced phase of the Apocalyptic Era. On all sides there are unmistakable signs, many foretold by Christ Himself in His Gospel: general apostasy; dreadful sins; abject morals as never before; villainous shepherds and teachers, whose words are deadly poison; atheistic teachings acknowledged and condoned on a universal scale; continual unlawful wars, with genocides left unpunished, many upheld by world organizations; great natural cataclysms with incalculable death-toll, allowed by God as a show of His Holy Wrath; seditions and disorders everywhere; repugnant diseases caused by vice; ambition and injustice without measure; impious governments; villainous laws; claims for false human rights and other aberrations; numberless criminal abortions protected by state legislation; utterly perverse and satanic genetic manipulation of human beings in abominable laboratories; famine and misery in very many places owing to pride, selfishness, waste and boundless opulence of the most powerful nations, and so forth. These, beloved children, are the multiple signs of Satan's universal reign in these Last Times, by divine permission. And this will go from bad to worse as long as Our Lord and God does not put a stop to it, since He is the only one who can remedy such a host of evils. In spite of all, the perverse world, ever more obstinate, disdains to see that it is hastening vertiginously towards the most ferocious and bloody conflagration there has ever been: the Third World War, now being incubated in all haste and whose symptoms are ever more alarming.

O beloved children! World tension is chilling, frightening. Yet all around they boast of peace, when the very stones ooze blood, death, explosions. Let the world prepare for the dreadful catastrophe on the way. Whole nations will be wiped out, and swarming cities will disappear, at the blast of the atomic armaments stockpiled in the great arsenals of powerful nations. They proclaim themselves guardians of peace before the world, while they are armed to the teeth; and besides, under the pretext of false peace, with brazen cynicism, and under the auspices of the masonic UN organization, they prevent other nations from supplying themselves with their own armaments, so that they alone be powerful, they alone be dominant and victorious. But no one makes fun of God. Those nations will be the most chastised. They will be savagely mauled, tearing one another to pieces. 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


Mark, dearest children: scoundrels impose themselves on present-day society on a worldwide scale. Those who uphold order find themselves oppressed by bands of scoundrels who parade around the streets and many other places. The most brazen subversion, including ruthless aggression, is practised against everything. In educational establishments, state and private, teaching as well is run-down, as teachers find themselves wholly defenceless against the assaults of wild pupils. Teachers and pupils, overwhelmed, denounce the deplorable fact. Civil insecurity is the norm owing to terrorism and delinquency on a large scale, often highly dangerous. Present-day society is in complete chaos. And what shall we say of the indecency and vulgarity reigning in town and city streets. Mark, the great Dominican preacher, Saint Vincent Ferrer, almost six centuries ago, foretold that when men were to dress like women and women like men, that would be the sure sign that the Last Times had come. In this respect Holy Palmarian Morals says: Present-day women's fashion is a brazen glorification of sensuality, and at the same time a debasement of femininity. Modern women, in their majority, have become spectres of indecency, ugliness, vulgarity and masculinity. Present-day men's fashion as well is an attack on Christian decency, by its extravagance, provocativeness, effeminacy, undress, and so forth. How many men are seen with earrings, women's hairstyles and other things typically woman's. We say nothing of transvestites, namely men who dress as women, a brazen aberration, which overturns God's natural plan regarding the male sex.

Beloved Palmarian faithful: at the sight of so much vileness and disaster in perspective, intensify your spirit of submission to the divine plans. Let your spirit of prayer and penance grow. Cast from your hearts any rebellious movement promoted by Satan against God and His Church. See, We repeat over again, the infernal Dragon, father of lies, does not ease up in his intent to seduce you into forming part of his kingdom of darkness. The accursed Serpent, who ruined our first parents, Adam and Eve, in paradise, is the same who continues to seduce the nations. Satan is master of the world. Only the children of the Church, who are yourselves, remain for him to conquer for his cause. The Devil, above all now as Antichrist, as Man of Iniquity, though still living his hidden life, watches over you, prowls about you, stalks you as a roaring lion to undo you, since you are the only prey he lacks. All Satan's endeavours are to overcome the children of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, since we are the only ones who do not belong to his accursed kingdom, the only ones who face up to him by our obedience to God and to His Holy Law. The malign enemy, Satan Incarnate, knows that he will never succeed against Christ's Holy Church, since she is indefectible, invincible and indestructible, thanks to the very promise of her Divine Founder: "The gates of Hell shall not prevail against Her". But he also knows that with his great vanquishing power, permitted by God, he can achieve notable success against those members of the Church who waver, who do not face up to him valorously, and who look back after having set their hand to the plough. We repeat over and over, a thousand and one times, that you keep ever on continuous watch like soldiers on the battlefield. The Devil, as intelligent angel, though fallen through pride, knows quite well the weak points of each of you, and when he cannot seduce by one means, at once he tries to succeed by another.

Be very firm, dear Palmarians! As children of the true Church that you are, and by virtue of the life of grace, you are in possession of the greatest treasure possible to acquire on earth, consisting of a triple indwelling in the soul: that of the supernatural virtue of Faith, by which you are tabernacles of all the mysteries of the Sacrosanct Treasure of Divine Revelation; that of the supernatural virtue of Hope, by which you trustingly hope to acquire Eternal Blessedness through the helps of grace and your good works; and that of the supernatural virtue of Charity, by which you love God above all things and your neighbour for love of God. By means of the life of grace you partake of the Kingdom of God as far as is possible in this world. In short, in the supernatural order you are true children of God and heirs to His Glory. So, dear children, do not defraud Him who died for you on the Cross of Calvary. With firm step follow His footprints along the Way of Bitter Sorrow, bearing with valour and generous purpose, the





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


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sufferings of the cross which are the lot of each to bear by God's inscrutable designs. Never cast your cross aside, however burdensome it may seem. The value of the cross borne christianly is scarcely to be appraised by man's poor mind, and only when one day you are in Heaven will you know, and appreciate fully, the true value of the cross Christ has placed on your shoulders, so that by its means you may have an efficacious part in His Sacrosanct Passion and Death. In your temptations, labours and sufferings, turn to your Heavenly Mother, the Virgin Mary. She collaborated with utmost purpose and generosity in the Work of Calvary, taking part in all the unspeakable sufferings of Her Divine Son. Call upon her with full confidence! Take Her always as Mistress and Guide! Be quite sure that, in Her Motherly Hands, you will always come out victorious, since by divine decree She treads Satan's proud head underfoot.

Beloved children: you participate in many of the divine Mysteries, while those who do not acknowledge the Palmarian Church, nor her Magisterial and Infallible Doctrine, are deprived of them. In you as well are fulfilled the words of Our Lord Jesus Christ, when He said: "I praise You, My Father, Lord of Heaven and earth, because You have hidden these great things from those held to be wise and prudent in this world, and have revealed them to the little and humble. O Father, thus it is because it has pleased You." How many mysteries do you know thanks to the Apparitions of the Most Holy Virgin Mary in El Palmar de Troya! How many mysteries have been revealed to the Church thanks to the magisterial and infallible teachings of Pope Saint Gregory XVII! How many too have come to light thanks to the Documents emanating from the Holy Dogmatic Palmarian Council and Synod! Thanks to Sacred History or the Holy Palmarian Bible, you have the authentic Sacred Scriptures in your hands, without any error. The apocalyptic mysteries themselves you know thanks to the magisterial and infallible interpretation of Saint John's Apocalypse, just as it is in our Holy Bible. You are aware of multiple and transcendent mysteries which have stayed hidden until the Holy Ghost revealed them to the Palmarian Church. O dear children, how great is God's predilection for you! You are bearers of the Light in the whole sense of the term. And to the contrary, what obscurity, what darkness, what error, what heresy in those outside the true Church! You, the little and humble, are the truly wise, because you know Christ's teaching in all authenticity; because you live according to the dictates of Divine Wisdom which are the Commandments of the Law of God and of the Church; because you partake of the heavenly wisdom possible in this life; because you go by the strait way of Wisdom; because you aspire to possess Heavenly Wisdom one day in Eternal Blessedness, in all perfection according to the measure of your merits. Christ as God and as Man is divine Wisdom, and you are grafted onto Wisdom by virtue of the supernatural life in your souls. Yet those held as wise and prudent in this world, live in the most deplorable ignorance. Folly is their hallmark. They believe they know it all, and with loud, empty and enticing words they dare to impose their ambiguous standards, their errors, their vanities, their false beliefs, on the rest. They teach heretical doctrines, because the truth for them is simply whatever fits in with their false beliefs and loose ways. They live in utter disorder, thick darkness clouds their minds, and they see no further than the mortal and stale. Wisdom for them is limited to purely earthly matters. Their arguments are contradictory. And in the world, the number of fools is incalculable.

Beloved children: as pertains to Satan's reign, in the modern world, as from many years back, ugliness, vulgarity, anti-aestheticism predominate in the majority of men. Satan, father of ugliness, is the one who inspires and imposes what we might call "art of the ugly." Art in general, save exceptions, is today totally opposed to true art. Painting, sculpture, music, and so forth, are really a degeneration of art, not to say an aberration. With respect to painting and sculpture, many of the works presented in expositions, in sales halls, in museums, and so on, are really mockeries, but fools esteem and applaud them. In public auctions, fabulous sums are paid for ridiculous, grotesque works, such as those of Picasso and others of like plumage. What a shame, what a waste, with famine in many lands! Yet true art is seen to be set aside, since those so-called artists now know only how to create freaks and mockeries.





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
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When We praise true art, at the same time We reprove the immodesty there is in many paintings and sculptures by great and true artists of the past, since they go against Holy Morals. Likewise the music which rules in this day of ugliness is a degeneration of the true art of music. On all sides accursed rock music, pop music and their derivatives, prevail and impose; infernal music consisting of horrible gesticulations, screams, excitation, lasciviousness, perturbation, ravings, and so on. And not only rock and its derivatives, but the greater part of present-day music as well is a caricature of what melodious, harmonious music can be; that is, it is really a laugh, so that today those called singersongwriters and groups abound. Today all modern music singers are successful, proof as well of the bad taste of the listeners in their majority. As for contempory classical music, so-called, today composers write real tin-pan serenades. It is a shame that in great concert halls highly prestigious orchestras lend themselves as well to interpret discordant, screeching, zany pieces, to call them by some name, antithesis of true musical art, and the packed audiences applaud with deafening frenzy. But such are things today. As for present-day literature, the same goes. Save for exceptions, there is a series of poets, novelists, playwrights and so on, whose writings are real rubbish, from the artistic, cultural, ideological and moral point of view; but today they call it literary art, and as such it is read, esteemed and awarded prizes. Atheism, impiety, sensuality and the rest, in their different species and perversity, are the poison transmitted in the majority of writings today. Clearly, that is what many of the readers like, and they are the ones who pay. In short, beloved Palmarian children, why go on, when you have it all close at hand, since it preponderates in today's society they call cultured, and what is worse, think it is too.

Beloved children of Our priestly soul: We bring up here a few points of Holy Palmarian Morals that you already know, but which are good to remind you of: today the discotheque, thus called, is the fashion. They are infernal places, where there is always a proximate danger of sin, given the scandalous dancing, the diabolical atmosphere, the infernal music, the provocative clothing, frightful shouts, movements, drinks, and so on. It is therefore completely forbidden to go to discotheques, owing to their open perversity. Therefore whoever publicly or privately co-operates in any way with those kinds of lascivious and scandalous dancing, or enters discotheques, sins mortally. Modern music, e.g.: rock and all its derivatives, etc., is a product of Satan himself. By means of that music all the lower passions of man are given free reign; and likewise hysteria, fanaticism, drug addiction, excessive drinking and many other psychical and physical disorders. Modern music is that most opposed to true musical art and is an infernal incentive to sensuality. Modern music opposes God's Infinite Beauty, Good Morals and sound artistic taste; and consequently is a grave danger; so that all are obliged to refrain from collaborating or letting themselves be influenced by that music, and reject it quite openly. Whoever has tapes or disks of that music, or expressly listens to them, sins mortally. Take into account that hearing is not listening; so that there is sin once that music is heard and then listened to with attention.

Beloved Palmarian children: the 20th of November this year, was the thirty-first anniversary of the death of Saint Francisco Franco, who gave such glory to Spain. How different is today's Spain from that which We lived in during the forty years of the reign of the great Caudillo, Generalissimo and Head of State, Saint Francisco Franco Bahamonde, undefeated champion of Catholicism, who resolutely laboured to re-establish the Kingdom of Christ in that Spain wrested from the impious, unclean and anarchical ocean of the republican government by his own hands. Franco's Spain was the Spain of national unity, of security, of deep piety, of holy Catholic morals, of justice, of respect for authority, of a wholesome way of life, of culture, of sound teaching, of economic and social prosperity, in short, of true peace. Yet today, with the greatest brazenness and contempt, the illustrious figure of the exalted Caudillo is denigrated, to the point that the Spain he wrested from anarchy and crime by means of a holy and lawful Crusade has turned its back on him with the greatest show of scorn and hatred. By way of various governmental orders, they have gone about removing his name from streets, doing away with his statues and every sign





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representing his glorious person and immortal labour, from Spain. What ingratitude! There are real campaigns to erase every idea in favour of the holy figure of Francisco Franco, and his fruitful labour, from the minds of children, youth and adults. Spain, poor Spain! You are not even the shadow of what you were! Spain, poor Spain! What will become of you! However much they toil against the labour of Saint Francisco Franco, they will never be able to erase his name from Spanish soil nor from beyond her frontiers. They can destroy his statues, denigrate his labour, but they will never be able to destroy his glory, since it is written in everlasting letters by Christ's hand in the Book of Life, in the Book of the Blessed. Yet the anarchy, crimes, sacrileges, unlawful infringements, injustices and so forth, of the masonic and unlawful Second Spanish Republic, are written in everlasting letters by Christ's hand in the Book of Death, in the book of the reprobates. Mark, beloved children, glorious Pope Saint Pius XII gave Saint Francisco Franco the greatest marks of appreciation and recognition for the mission the valorous Caudillo had carried out in the Church and in Spain. It suffices to recall that, on the 21st of December 1953, Saint Pius XII bestowed on Saint Francisco Franco the extraordinary distinction of the Supreme Order of Christ, imposed on him by the cardinal primate, following the reading of the pontifical brief.

Beloved faithful children: We avail Ourself of this Apostolic Letter to underline once again the inestimable value of the Holy Sacrament of Extreme Unction. We have reports that one or other Palmarian, at symptoms of serious illness, have been more concerned to take the sick person to hospital than to procure beforehand the administration of the Sacrament of Extreme Unction, when there was occasion to receive it. Beloved children, this is quite opposed to the dispositions of the Church. It is good, and besides a duty, to procure lawful, necessary and proportionate means to safeguard bodily health, as would be the hospitalization of a sick person when truly needed and there is hope of a cure. But before bodily health comes health of the soul, and all Palmarian faithful should bear this much in mind. According to our Holy Morals, by the Sacrament of Extreme Unction, the soul of the sick person is at the same time purified further from sin and fortified in the life of grace; and the body as well is fortified, if suited to the health of the soul. Extreme Unction works in a very special way when those who receive it are seriously ill and dying, they being exceedingly fortified for the last combat and to confront death with Christian resignation; and thereby gain greater glory in Heaven. Besides, Extreme Unction has the special effect of forgiving mortal sin when the sick person, if unable to confess, receives it with attrition for sin.

The reception of Holy Extreme Unction, then, is a precept which obliges, under pain of mortal sin, all the faithful of the Church who, gravely ill, have the possibility of receiving this Sacrament. The sick person, and his household as well, are obliged, under mortal sin, to call the Priest to administer Extreme Unction when the sick person is still fully conscious. Besides, the Sacrament of Extreme Unction can be received as often as necessary, for it is very advisable and beneficial for the sick to receive Extreme Unction with certain frequency in the case of serious and prolonged illnesses; above all when the sick person is unable to receive Communion; given that by Extreme Unction he will be considerably strengthened. And should the patient have already died, it should be administered conditionally; accordingly, though knowing that the sick person has already died, the Priest should be called so that he administer Extreme Unction conditionally, according to his upright judgement.

Though the Sacrament of Extreme Unction is for the seriously ill faithful, included among them are the very elderly as well, since they are more prone to death owing to their ailments. Consequently, the Missionary Bishops in their respective dioceses, before coming to the Holy Apostolic See, should administer Extreme Unction to the very elderly as well, whether ill or not. And the same applies to those who have to undergo surgery, given that it is very advisable and beneficial for the sick person to receive Extreme Unction before the operation, whether serious or not, for the danger of some grave unforeseen complication that might cause death. Women who are due to give birth





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as well, should make sure to receive Holy Extreme Unction beforehand, since giving birth too has serious risks, above all if a caesarian operation were necessary.

Beloved Palmarian faithful: in these times the number of sects or false churches that exist is practically incalculable. Everyone has forged his own religion according to his fancy, his beliefs and lax way of life. But the world should take very much into account that, infallibly, outside the true Church, One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian, salvation is not possible. No one can save himself if he is not grafted onto the true Saving Vine, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and as obvious consequence, in the Church founded by Him. Christ is the Invisible Head of His Mystical Body or Holy Church, and Mary is the Neck, so that the Church founded by Him is also necessarily the true Vine, since the Head and the Body form an indissoluble whole, and the Body receives life of grace from the Head via the Neck. By divine disposition, regarding the Church Militant, namely the faithful who still pilgrim on earth. in order that they live grafted onto the Whole Vine or Mystical Body of Christ, it is absolutely necessary that they be united to the Visible Head, the Pope, to whom Christ has entrusted the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven. The Sacrament of the Papacy, conferred by Christ on the Pope, is the Master Key to the other seven Sacraments, by which graces are distributed, and the Pope possesses full power to bind and to loose. Such is the need to be united to the Pope, that those who dispense with Him cannot form part of Christ's Mystical Body nor aspire to the Eternal Kingdom promised. Christ and the Pope are mystically one single Gate to the Fold of Salvation, and only by the Visible Head can one have access to the Invisible Head, and therefore to Christ's Mystical Body or Holy Church. From this is understood that eternal salvation is solely attainable within the true Church, given that the Body receives the life of grace from the Invisible Head, and only those partake of this who are supernaturally grafted onto Christ's Mystical Body by way of communion with the Pope. Quite simply and categorically: those who are not with the Pope are against Christ and against His Church. Let the entire world know that the true Church of Christ is the Palmarian Catholic Church, with Apostolic See in El Palmar de Troya, and that the true Vicar of Christ is Ourself, Peter II Pope.

Beloved faithful: The solemn ceremonies on New Year's Day in the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar will take place in the following order: At 1 am, a turn of Holy Masses on the High Altar and on other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Penitential Rosary. At 10 am, the Most Solemn Pontifical Masses, with the recital of the Holy Trisagion. At 6 pm, a turn of Holy Masses on the High Altar and all the other Altars with the recital of the Holy Way of the Cross. There will also be turns, day and night, of Masses and Penitential Rosaries. At 9 pm, will be the Most Solemn Procession with the Sacred Images of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar and Most Holy Crowned Saint Joseph of Palmar.

Palmarian Faithful: Come all on pilgrimage to El Palmar de Troya, for New Year's Eve 2006 and New Year's Day 2007! Be generous and respond to the Calling of the Vicar of Christ! Help the Church's many undertakings with your alms!



We, Peter II, Supreme Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of St Peter, Servant of the Servants of God, Patriarch of Palmar de Troya, de Cruce Apocalyptica, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We, as Universal Father, call all the faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church to come on pilgrimage to the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar on the occasion of the Most Solemn Worship of Holy Week 2007, which will commence on the forthcoming 1st of April, Palm Sunday, and will finalize on Easter Sunday the 8th.

Most beloved children, your presence in this Sacred Place on such outstanding feasts is most appropriate, so that you be strengthened ever more in the faith, and be able to maintain yourselves always firm amidst the rampant apostasy and great approaching upheavals. Remember the words of the Divine Master to His Apostles on the night He was to be given up: "Watch and pray so that you do not fall in temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." If the Apostles abandoned Christ in the Garden of Olives, it was precisely because at that supreme hour, they lacked the true spirit of prayer and sacrifice, despite the reiterated warnings of Our Divine Saviour, Who, by His example of praying to the Heavenly Father, also taught them how they should successfully face up to the onslaughts of Satan. In this hour of the power of darkness, the life of the Palmarian faithful must more than ever be steadfast in watchfulness and prayer. We exhort you not to slacken your vigilance, not one bit, since at each step great dangers await you, and your eyes must always be wide open so as not to stumble and fall. See how, on the way of salvation many who beforehand were even models for you in virtue, are falling in a spectacular fashion. It is extremely lamentable and sad that this happens, but divine





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



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help was not lacking for them to continue onward. They are the ones who have squandered the graces received, which were not a few, because in the Holy Palmarian Church these fall in torrents.

Yet, alas, most beloved children, family members many times are the worst enemies of your faith. Hence Our Lord Jesus Christ said: "Do you think I have come to bring peace on earth? I tell you, no; rather division. Because for My cause henceforth five in one home shall be divided, three against two, and two against three. They shall be divided: husband against wife, and wife against husband; father against son, and son against father; mother against daughter, and daughter against mother; brother against brother, mother-in-law against daughter-in-law, and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law." Despite Our Lord's words, so clear and categorical, there are still some not giving them their true meaning. These words seem now to lack application in our times, while false charity is preached and valued, God's rights are trodden underfoot and misunderstood human rights are emphasized. The sentence of Christ is directed precisely and more especially to the Apocalyptic Times we live in! What problems are caused us by the enemies of our Palmarian Catholic Faith. At each step they set up traps so that Palmarians abandon the way of virtue and, like them, give themselves over to worldly things opposed to salvation. They are not prepared even to respect our faith and holy morals. Be ever firm and uncompromising with the children of darkness, who lamentably are more sagacious than the children of light. Charity towards your neighbour must always be accompanied by holy steadfastness, because if you give way to worldly impositions true charity is trodden underfoot, since your duty to God and to the Church would be downgraded to the stipulations of the accursed Dragon. The infernal and desperate growls of some apostates can be heard with greater resonance on more than a few occasions, but we cannot stop to throw stones at dogs who bark at us along the way; our duty is to continue forward without taking notice of what they do and say, which is the greatest contempt we can show to Satan and his followers.

Most beloved children: Consider the following sentence from the Book of Proverbs in the Holy Palmarian Bible: "The way of the righteous is a shining light that increases daily and grows to perfection." As most faithful children of Holy Church that you are, the way of your sanctification is well indicated, clearly defined and quite luminous, and its goal is the possession of eternal glorification in Heaven. Our Lord Jesus Christ left this marked out with the most holy and heroic example of His life on earth. For those who truly wish to follow in the footsteps of Our Divine Saviour, the way of perfection will be more resplendent each day, although sprinkled with thorns, in imitation of the Dolorous Way that Christ and Mary followed on the Way of Calvary. Let nobody think that eternal salvation can be attained without a continual renouncement of all that is opposed to it. Let nobody believe that sanctification is a road of softness, comforts, compliments, in a word of human complacencies. The light of the way of the upright receives its ever more resplendent vigour, precisely by virtue of the generous commitment of those following it. And the greater the acceptance of the Cross, the greater the supernatural luminosity possible in this world, and incomparably more perfect the glorification received forever in Heaven. Because, see, most beloved children, with greater immolation will come greater perfection and greater interior luminosity. The Holy Ghost, the Light by Essence Who dwells in the souls of the upright, that is, souls in the state of grace, which is only possible within the true Church, is He who works with His Seven Gifts, supernaturally vivifying the soul, which He illuminates and sanctifies more and more, according to response to grace. While it is true that we children of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church,





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live crucified, yet this crucifixion entails in itself the corresponding supernatural glorification corresponding to this earthly life, which glorification is the possession of Divine Life itself, an inexhaustible well-spring growing more in the soul each day, which well-spring will flow into the ocean of eternal happiness, where perfect sanctity or full glorification will be attained, according to personal merits.

The same Book continues saying: "The way of the ungodly, on the contrary, is a tenebrous light which augments daily and grows to complete obscurity." The way of perdition is ever more tenebrous for the ungodly, and its goal is eternal darkness. The way marked out by Satan is quite spacious, ever open to errors and other corruptions of the world. And in travelling it, the soul goes along speedily precipitating itself into the depths of its obscure abysms, returning being more difficult each day, because of the ever increasing infernal darkness. So then, those who, having had possession of supernatural light, later despise it and cast it from them, will cling more to their errors and find it more difficult to separate themselves from vice and other worldly complacencies. Woe to those who being children of the light and later on fall into the clutches of Satan, who in his being is darkness itself. If they do not remedy the situation in time, responding to the actual graces God gives them, they will irremediably follow diabolical inspirations and directions, until they fall into total obscurity, which is eternal darkness. Oh yes, most beloved children, the way of iniquity gives to those who travel it ample facilities for them to follow its course without any turning back. The more man plunges into errors and vices, the more he likes and encourages them and the greater his difficulties in reflecting honourably to withdraw himself from them, since his pride and adherence thereto will not permit this. Do not forget that the infernal Dragon, the accursed Serpent, who encloses within himself all error, obscurity and vice, is the father of lies, the great seducer, pride itself, who knows how to nourish his followers with delicacies ever more pleasing and appetising in order to keep them subject to his dominion.

Dearly beloved Palmarian faithful: You are compelled, each according to his state, to be entirely faithful to God's plans. Nobody can excuse himself from this duty. To follow the way of the upright, it is necessary that you raise aloft the flag of Christ's army, struggling like valorous soldiers on the battlefield, which is this earthly life. Unconcern and cowardice are totally incompatible with your status as true Christians. The religious must struggle as religious, the single lay person as such, the married as married, widows as widows, the aged as aged and so forth. Each one has his mission in the struggle against the soul's enemies. You are all made of flesh and blood, inclined to evil, liable to falls. Hence the struggle is an unavoidable duty if you desire to remain steadfast in virtue, so as later to attain in the Heavenly Fatherland, the thrones of glory prepared by God, according to the merits of each one. We again repeat that once the hand is laid to the plough, there are no intermissions, and much less turning back, that is if one desires to till successfully the fields of eternal salvation. Do not forget, most beloved faithful, your most high privilege to be children of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, the true Fold of Christ, sole Ark of Salvation, since outside the authentic Church salvation is not possible. Amidst an apostate and corrupted world you are the favourite children of God, Our Lord, and this sublime and supernatural divine filiation you possess by your status as Palmarian faithful. We desire that you, children of the Church, make a gigantic leap forward along the way of sanctification. We ardently yearn that all of you be more committed, more generous, and holier every day. To do so you must place yourselves in the arms of Our Heavenly Mother, the Most Holy Virgin Mary, with the complete security that, faithful to Her, you





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will encounter the costly treasure of sanctity, priceless in value. Have full confidence in the maternal perpetual succour of She who is Mother of God and Our Mother. Put yourselves as well under the patronage of Joseph Most Holy, whose intercession is most powerful before the throne of his Divine Spouse. How little some know of the most faithful protection of Saint Joseph over those who confidently invoke him.

Most beloved children of Our Papal Heart: We now speak again about the greatness of Religious Life, which is the preferred garden of the Church. In Religious Life, by a most generous surrender in the service of God, is where the most beautiful flowers grow, among these the white lily of perfect chastity. Religious Life is the orchard of the loves of Christ and Mary. Souls of the religious faithfully given over to the fulfilment of the Holy Rule are more resplendent than the sun, since God lavishes over them supernatural luminosity with unimaginable potency. O beloved friars and nuns! What greatness, what loftiness, what brilliance, that of the souls of religious who live given over with full generosity, within the walls of the convent, in the service of their Divine Spouses Christ and Mary. They are mystical flowers with exuberant perfume, with beautiful and indescribable colours of a splendorous supernatural brilliance. O most beloved children, there is no state more perfect, more sublime and more delightful than that of the Religious Life, since it is the selfsame State of Perfection! The sanctity a good religious can attain is inconceivable in degree and merit. Certainly in the garden of the Religious Life there are, of course, arduous thorns that penetrate and purify. Without those thorn-pricks, the soul of the religious would be dispossessed of the merits inherent to the life of true surrender to God. The religious, then, renounces the world and all personal belongings, makes heroic efforts to subject the flesh to the spirit, and unconditionally subjects his or her own will to the Divine Will. This complete and generous abnegation, entailed in fulfilment of the Holy Religious Vows and Holy Rule, comprises the essence of the sanctity of the Religious Life. The true religious, then, lives dispossessed of all that opposes the State of Perfection voluntarily and generously embraced. The authentic religious has nothing yet possesses all things. As the exalted reformatrix of Carmel, Saint Teresa of Jesus says; "Whoever has God lacks nothing", and this is fulfilled in its most authentic and perfect sense in the convent life lived each hour of the day for God alone. In Religious Life, service of God is the culmination of all the holy aspirations possible in this earthly life; this generous service, then, is generally accompanied by a lofty divine love, sublime charity, great spiritual consolation and by evangelical peace in the deepest meaning of Christ's words: "Peace I leave you, My peace I give you. I do not give it to you as the world does."

Thus, beloved children, a bad friar or a bad nun is the antithesis of true religious life. By his life of tepidity the clear waters of conventual sanctity are muddied, and may even become polluted if not purified in time. A bad religious can cause considerable harm in a convent. By bad example he sows cockle at times difficult to eradicate. Hence the superior, in charity and diligence, must quickly remedy a pernicious situation of a community harmed by members neither willing to sanctify themselves, nor, owing to their malign influence, let the others sanctify themselves. So many convents have collapsed through the tepidity and corruption of some members! One thing is the miseries and imperfections proper to fallen human nature that even the most saintly religious must struggle against day by day, and another is indifference to self-correction and lack of interest in attaining sanctity. The friar or nun who does not aspire to sanctification of soul is a spurious member, a rotten fruit in the divine garden of Religious Life. May God preserve us, beloved children, from a lax convent!





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


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Slackness causes nausea to God Himself, fountain of all sanctity, driving force of Religious Life or State of Perfection. So many religious at Particular Judgment have been sentenced to a very long and most painful purgatory! And what is sadder, so many religious, by their obstinate non-fulfilment of the Holy Rule are in the depths of Hell's eternal fire! The bad religious will be judged with great severity by Christ, the Supreme Judge.

We turn now to speak a little on married life: As you all know, Marriage is a Sacrament instituted by Our Lord Jesus Christ to legitimize and sanctify the union between man and woman; and to give them, as well, the graces necessary to fulfil with dignity the obligations of this state. Among other excellences, the Sacrament of Matrimony is the Holy Priesthood of Procreation, which empowers husband and wife to exercise legitimately and with dignity the office of spouses and parents, as the husband is representative of Christ and the wife representative of the Church, within their marriage. God the Creator, endowing man and woman with their respective procreating seeds, has delegated in them the lofty mission of engendering children within true marriage, a sacred and ineluctable mission. The transmission of life is, then, a sacred power God has given to man and woman, who participate in His creative power. God collaborates in the human act of procreation by creating an immortal soul, infusing it into the new being at the very instant of conception. So, spouses have assumed the great responsibility to give to God the number of children He wishes to grant them. Procreation is, then, the first and principal end of marriage. So that, all those who feel called to the married state must know beforehand that married life is not a union for pleasure, but of very grave commitment before God in the work of procreation. It is true that the procreating mission in matrimony involves the legitimate and holy pleasure proper to the conjugal act; the pleasure, however, would be illicit and sinful if it were to oppose the procreating plan established by God. Therefore, this pleasure must always be subordinate, without any possible excuse, to the loftiest duty of procreation, which is to transmit life to other beings. So, a most heinous crime would be committed against God if, in the conjugal act, the intention to engender children be excluded in any way. Including venial sin would be committed if the conjugal act was realized solely for pleasure, even though the intention to fulfil the primary end of marriage was not excluded. Spouses should always bear in mind that the duty of procreation entails heroic acts, to the point where the mother must always be willing, including to give her life for the being she carries in her womb. Excuses are not valid. Married couples committed themselves before God and before the Church to procreate the number of children God wishes to grant them. Blessed be the mother who dies through fulfilling the will of God, cooperating with the Creator in the Work of Creation. Blessed be that mother who, in reward for her collaboration in the Work of Creation, receives the palm of martyrdom. Married life is firstly and principally of sacrifice, and the legitimate human complacencies that conjugal life proportions are subject to the most sacred duties inherent to marriage. We repeat again: There can be no excuse whatsoever! By no means can an assault be made against the duty of procreation by not having children or restricting their number. Those who act in this way fall under the curse of God and of Ours.

Those who desire to be united through the Sacrament of Matrimony must know that marrying has to be a vocational act. Since in addition to matrimony validly contracted being indissoluble by divine right, and only at the death of one of the spouses is the marriage bond severed, married couples are called to fulfil certain obligations, many of them painful, and have to be prepared to accept the will of God with generous surrender. The first moments of conjugal life are usually straightforward, but as time passes marriage becomes a veritable





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cross, and it is then that spouses must demonstrate their authentic matrimonial vocation. How many couples have failed in their married life for having entered wedlock with egoistic views, and not with the generosity required by the Holy Sacrament of Matrimony! And when the delightful moments pass and bitter times arrive, disillusions, disagreements and even separations arise, instead of demonstrating heroically their unconditional surrender to the service of God within the indissoluble matrimonial state they freely and voluntarily accepted. Marriage necessarily implies, on the one hand, the intimate living together of man and woman, along with the upsets that frequently arise in those intimate relations. On the other hand, the wife's discomforts proper to gestation and giving birth, along with her household obligations, and the husband's duty of facing up to the family needs. To all this must be added the sustenance, education and other obligations to the children, often with great suffering, due to economic difficulties, illnesses and many other family reverses and misfortunes. So, most beloved engaged couples, before making the final decision to contract matrimony, you should consider it well, subjecting your reflections to prayer in order to implore divine light and help. Do not undertake things lightly. Matrimony is a very serious matter, as it entails a most grave responsibility; even so, the grace of God will not be lacking in the difficult trials of married life.

We, Peter II, Pope, desire to emphasize the virtue of purity, especially in the young, in these times when impurity is propagated everywhere and most blatantly declared licit. In this completely corrupted world the sublime virtue of purity is trodden underfoot in society, and the foment of the opposing vice, which is impurity, is extolled and provided with all means favourable to its greater spread and development. For the great majority of present day young, purity lacks value, is something outdated. The young of both sexes live immersed in the vice of impurity, considering it as something natural and reasonable. The Sixth Commandment of God's Law no longer exists for them, because it opposes carnal concupiscence. The great majority of young girls no longer apprize virginity, that beautiful seal which exceedingly dignifies the single woman, and which should remain inviolable until marriage. For those young girls of today, to preserve their virginity intact before contracting matrimony is a human point of view from other times. Thus feel and live the immense majority of the young, giving no importance to what others say, and even making fun of those who disapprove of their wantonness. See, most beloved children, the following sentence from the Book of Wisdom on the impure: "O how vile and repugnant is the generation of those who love impurity! Its fruits are harmful and bitter to eat, because they are borne by trees corrupted by wanton lasciviousness. The Lord will abominate those obstinate in depravity; since if not converted, they shall die without honour and be eternally disgraced amongst the other reprobates; because God will destroy their inordinate passions, reducing them to silence and utter desolation; and their remembrance shall perish forever. Their disorders will rise up against them, and accuse and torment them without end."

But you, dearly beloved Palmarian youths, you well know that the vice of impurity, in whatever form, is a most grievous offence to God, and moreover gives rise to disastrous consequences of every kind. You, who appreciate the great value of purity, must love it and possess it as a most precious and valuable jewel. Struggle firmly against the opposing vice, forsake rapidly the occasions of sin, subjecting your bodies to discipline. While it is true that in the young it is more difficult to subject concupiscent movements of the flesh to the spirit, yet it is always possible with the grace of God. All the Saints were of flesh and blood also, subject to





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concupiscent impulses, but they overcame with divine help, struggling against them. Holy chastity is attained by prayer, penance and vigilance, by personal effort and the continual practice of this virtue. Whoever valiantly struggles against impurity, in the end wins the battle. And if sometimes a fall is unfortunately incurred, have recourse promptly to the Sacrament of Penance, to recover grace and receive new strength to continue struggling. Never be dismayed! Always go onward in the combat! Whoever is discouraged by falling and abandons the struggle, will become subject to the slavery of vice. It is highly meritorious to suffer patiently the disordered movements that are proper to our fallen nature, persistently rejecting them with the help of grace. Temptations must be rejected as soon as they begin, not permitting them to augment. Supreme diligence must be employed in acting. Most beloved children, receive Holy Communion frequently. Come to the Most Holy Virgin Mary, whose succour is most efficacious to overcome the suggestions and instigations of Satan and to subdue the rebellion of the flesh. We know by experience that, whoever entrusts his or her purity to the Virgin Mary and invokes Her with confidence, especially in temptation, is assured of victory. Commend your purity to Our Heavenly Mother and you will see the efficacious results. How lovely is purity in youth. Chastity has the glory, the value and the merit of martyrdom, and makes man similar to the Angels. Chastity produces interior peace and the happiness proper to winning. The youth who remains chaste will arrive at marriage with vigour and enthusiasm. For him it will be a delight to unite his life in holiness with the person he loves. He will feel greater strength to struggle and face up to the problems of his new state. See, beloved children, the following sentence from the Book of Wisdom about the chaste: "The remembrance of the chaste is immortal, since their virtue is acknowledged before God and men. While on earth they are models for imitation; and when dead are remembered with admiration. In Heaven they will be eternally recompensed with the crown of triumph entailed in the reward for their continuous battle on earth to conserve chastity. The grace to see God is reserved for those who are clean of heart."

Most beloved Palmarian Apostles: The Reign of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, at present in the Mystical Desert of El Palmar de Troya, will soon be spread around the different nations of the globe. The One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, ever vigorous and resplendent, will be the wonder of humanity. To this glorious triumph all of you are collaborating by you generous commitment in the service of God. Your suffering, your renouncement, your heroic patience, amidst a world that despises and censures you for being Palmarian faithful, will be recompensed in an extraordinary way. Many of those who persecute you now will have to lay down their pride and humble their heads. They will come to this Blessed Ground of the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, See of the true Church of Christ and kiss it, inundating it with their tears. All will be fulfilled, dearly beloved children, and those who do not see these events from earth, being already in Heaven, will contemplate them in an immensely more perfect vision from there. We bring to you here the words of Christ on the occasion of the parable of the wicked judge and the widow: "Do you think that God will not give justice to His elect who cry out to him day and night, and that He will leave their pleas unattended for long? I tell you that He will promptly give them justice." All your efforts to maintain yourselves firm in the Palmarian Faith will be fully recompensed. All those who persecute you now, if they do not repent will receive their punishment. Pray intensely for the conversion of sinners, of course, and most especially for those who harm the Church by their calumnies. Poor things, they deserve pity, since they are the ones harmed, as nobody makes fun of God, and sooner or later they will have to render an account to the Supreme Judge. The rotten





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world you live in will soon be transformed when Christ establishes the Messianic Kingdom on earth at His Glorious Second Coming. Everything is very near, most beloved children. Evil will be destroyed by the divine breath. But beforehand, Holy Church will be terribly combated by Antichrist and his followers. Many Palmarians, in defence of their faith, will suffer atrocious martyrdoms, as never before. Many of you will be witnesses to future Apocalyptic events. Antichrist-in-person who is now on earth, although still in his hidden life, will not delay many years in publicly manifesting himself. Observe, on the 13th of December in the year 2000, Glorious Pope Saint Gregory XVII, by reason of entering the Third Millennium of the Christian Era in the year 2001, said in a sermon "Without the least misgiving Christ is going to return in the third millennium, and very near the beginning of this third millennium, within the first century of this third millennium, very near to the middle of this century."

Most beloved children of Our Papal Heart: Ever aspire to the Supreme Happiness promised by God to those who love Him, which is the supernatural end of man! Do not be in conformity with the perishable things of the world. Look ever towards Heaven. And although your feet walk on earth, perceptibly damaged by original sin, your path on it is only to fulfil the divine plans. You are called to live in an immortal Homeland where order and perfection reign and nothing is lacking. Let your thoughts, your desires and aspirations be forever most elevated. Be sober in everything, and never give scandal by your bad behaviour. When a Palmarian gives scandal he discredits the Catholic Faith he professes, and therefore discredits the Church of Christ. Take care with alcoholic drinks! Be sober. Lately there have been some youths who have given scandal in the village of El Palmar de Troya through drunkenness. Such a thing is intolerable, beloved children. We hope it will not happen again.

The Palmarian Holy Week programme for the year 2007 will have the following daily timetable of worship: At 1 am there will be a turn of Holy Masses on the Main Altar and on other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Penitential Rosary; at 10 am, the Most Solemn Pontifical with the recital of the Holy Trisagion; at 6 pm a turn of Holy Masses on the Main Altar as well as on the other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Way of the Cross; at 9 pm the corresponding Procession. Besides, there will be turns of Masses and Penitential Rosaries day and night. Apart from brief intervals, the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of El Palmar will remain open day and night throughout the Holy Week.

The Processions of Holy Week will have the following order: Palm Sunday: Our Father Jesus Scourged and Crowned with Thorns; Our Mother Spiritually Scourged and Crowned with Thorns. Holy Monday: Our Father Jesus bearing the Cross; and Our Mother of Bitter Sorrow. Holy Tuesday: Most Holy Christ of Palmar, Light of the World; Our Sorrowful Mother of Palmar, Morning Star. Holy Wednesday: Christ Reparator, Mary Co-Reparatrix. Maundy Thursday: Christ Eternal High Priest; and Christ Redeemer, Mary Co-Redemptrix and Saint John Evangelist (the Calvary scene). Good Friday: Most Holy Recumbent Christ and Our Mother of the Pietà. Holy Saturday: Most Holy Risen Christ, and Our Mother of the Dawn. Easter Sunday: Most Solemn Corpus Christi Procession.

Finally, we insist yet again that you bear much in mind the enormous expenses incurred in the Most Solemn Holy Week Worship, and that you do your best, according to your means, to collaborate with your generous alms as you have always done.

Faithful Palmarians! Come all to the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya for Holy Week this year 2007.

FIFTEENTH APOSTOLIC LETTER

Pilgrimage to El Palmar de Troya for the Feast of Carmel 2007. Some exhortations on the apostolate of the Palmarian Tertiary Faithful


We, Peter II, Sovereign Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of Palmar de Troya, *de Cruce Apocalyptica*, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We, as Universal Pastor, call all the faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, to come on pilgrimage to the Cathedral-Basilica for the occasion of the Most Solemn Worship on the 16th of July 2007, Principal Feast of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, Queen of Carmel and Universal Patroness.

Dearly beloved children: We commence the present Apostolic Letter by exhorting you, once again, to live in sanctity amidst this idolatrous world, knowing how to value the very high privilege you enjoy of being children of the authentic Church, the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian. You are possessors of True Wisdom and bearers of Sanctity. By virtue of the indwelling of the Drop of Mary's Blood in your souls in the state of grace, Our Lord Jesus Christ and the Divine Mary, and with Him all the Most Blessed Trinity, are really and truly present in them. You, therefore, are Tabernacles of the Living God, of the Holy God, of the Almighty God and of the Infinite God in all His infinite Attributes. When you pass through the streets of the town, when at your work and in your studies, penetrate with your understanding, with your mind and with your senses into the depths of your souls, so that in this way you become more conscious of the Divine Treasure you possess. In this fashion you will become accustomed to living in the presence of God, with distaste for worldly things, keeping yourselves from being infected by the repugnant moral leprosy rampant in the world.

Most beloved children: The fundamental basis of your apostolate is the life of grace, the life of prayer and the life of penance. If you long to convert your non-palmarian relatives and friends, if you desire to draw to the true faith the enormous multitude that today lives beyond the truth, at the mercy of satanic beliefs and ideologies, if you wish to draw out of the sepulchres those who live under the slavery of sin and resurrect them for Christ, in the first place you must demonstrate before them that in yourselves there is supernatural life and not death, that there is virtue and not sin, giving testimony by your good example as true children of the Church and bearers of Christ, Who gives and conserves divine life in the soul, since without Christ you can do nothing. Your apostolate as tertiary faithful, therefore, must first and foremost be by good example. It would be contradictory, absurd and inefficacious to try to convince others if they see that you do not give testimony by your lives of what you preach. Furthermore, it would be altogether destructive, as you would discredit your own Palmarian Faith and give occasion for them to deride Holy Church. First you should preach by example. In what does preaching by example consist? To live with Christ, by Christ and for Christ: it is an inexcusable requirement, and the apostolate must





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encompass all: home, school, university, place of work, in town or wherever. As the apostles you are, your life has always to be apostolic.

Therefore, Palmarian faithful, you are faced with the duty of being irreproachable models, firstly in the bosom of your homes: Parents as parents, and children as children. Day by day you must exert yourselves to fulfil the obligations proper to each one within the family, with integrity and perfection, in this way trying to help one another mutually. Fidelity in fulfilling duty brings with it greater spiritual union, and a more harmonious coexistence between the members of the family; and on the contrary, disloyalty or indifference in fulfilling obligations leads to disunion and to disorder. Many parents have apostatized through not imposing their legitimate authority on their children, who in the end drew them out of the Church. On the other hand, so many children have thrown themselves into the arms of the degenerate world after seeing the bad example of their parents! Palmarian parents must ever keep watch over the good behaviour of their children, exhorting them to virtue, correcting their defects, chastising them when necessary and not yielding to anything that could morally stain the family temple, which is a prolongation of the Temple of God. Palmarian children must always behave with submission and obedience, showing before parents and other family members that they are faithful compliers of their obligations, contributing in this way to the supernatural maintenance of the family edifice that must become holier every day. The holiness of the Palmarian family is in consonance with the holiness of each of its members. The greater the holiness of its members, the greater will be the combined holiness of the family society.

Regarding intimate conjugal life, We say to Palmarian parents: couples that do not fulfil their duties are morally destroying their families, as they act like the woodworm which irreparably destroys everything it gnaws, quite hidden from sight. What authority, what moral ascendancy can parents have over their children when in their private lives they do not fulfil the Divine Law and the dispositions of the Church in what concerns their sacred procreating mission? If they are not faithful to God, with what force can they demand their children to be so? Thus, the apostolate of parents in the bosom of the family basically consists in being models before God, who sees all, and in being models before their children, in whom the good or bad conduct of their progenitors always redounds in good or evil, respectively. Palmarian couples loyal to their conjugal procreating duties, having the children God wishes to send them, give testimony before the world too as compliers of Divine Law and Holy Morals; which is a great apostolate amidst an apostate, corrupt and egoistic society, where parents, in their great majority, are totally opposed to matrimonial fecundity, and use every aberrant means within their reach to avoid it. How great is the apostolate of parents who, by example, proclaim to the world that they are faithful to the Commandments of God and the Church in what concerns their procreating duties! What a holy and efficacious way to teach others! What a great secular apostolate!

Now, outside the family circle, Palmarians must be apostles with each other as well, exhorting one another to become better every day, correcting as often as necessary, and mutually helping one another as the brethren they are in the Blood of Christ. May divine charity ever be resplendent in you, Palmarian faithful. How great is the apostolate of holy fraternal love! By the love between you they will acknowledge you as children of one same Father, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and of one same Mother, the Most Holy Virgin Mary; in short, that you are children of the true Church, the Catholic Palmarian, born on Calvary from the Most Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary transpierced. We repeat again: How lovely, how





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


edifying, and how efficacious is the apostolate of love between brethren in conformity with the charity of Christ! O most beloved children, never let there be quarrels, egoism and falsity among you! That is not proper to a holy brotherhood whose link is the Blood of Christ and the Blood of Mary espoused with the blood of each of you. Let no one complain when a brother in the Faith corrects him fraternally because he has broken some norm of the Church. There is a grave duty before God to admonish the wayward and to teach the ignorant. They are works of mercy. Whoever is corrected should not be angry; but on the contrary be grateful to his brother for the opportunity he gives him to amend. What a great apostolate fraternal correction is! What a great apostolate Christian charity is! By the love between you they will know that you are true disciples of Christ. By your good fruits they will acknowledge that you are branches grafted onto the luxuriant Tree of the Church: The One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian.

What can be said to you, most beloved children, of your apostolate in schools, universities and places of work? It is overwhelmingly logical that construction of an edifice begins by laying solid foundations, so that later the walls can be built with security, without risk of collapsing. It would be madness to set up an edifice on shifting sands. Therefore, the apostolate in schools, universities and work places, consists primordially in carrying on with your supernatural life amidst the corrupt and hostile atmosphere usually surrounding you. Let your companions see that you are unfailing in your doctrinal and moral convictions, that you are irreproachable compliers in your scholarly and working duties, that you are unyielding towards all that is opposed to the Law of God and the teaching of Holy Church, that you are not a reed shaken by the first wind that blows; in a word, that you are bearers of the saving message of Christ. Manifest yourselves with personality. Let cowardice and faint-heartedness be far from you. An apostle has to be valiant, sincere, upright, energetic, a defender of truth and uncompromising with untruths. You are obliged to give testimony of your Palmarian Catholic Faith as often as favourable occasions present themselves.

It is indeed true that your contact with companions in class or at work is limited to affairs purely related to study or to professional work so long as they, in their form of dress, are contrary to Palmarian norms, or live in concubinage. But if one of these companions asks why you avoid friendly acquaintances, you should tell him why in few words, so that he learn how to dress correctly and behave according to Holy Morals, without you being permitted any other verbal apostolate with him. And if some companion correctly dressed and not living in concubinage shows interest in being informed about the Palmarian Church, you ought to inform him precisely in what is necessary, so that the light of truth shine amidst the darkness, but without engaging in arguments on religious matters. Limit yourselves to teaching the truth of your Catholic Faith, simply and without letting yourselves be indoctrinated, since your apostolic mission is to teach and not to listen to the teaching of those outside the Palmarian Church. Once the light is placed on the candlestick, pray for them and leave things in the hands of God; and if today they give no credit to your testimony, perhaps later they will react favourably to the truth and agree with you, as in the depths of the soul some ray of the light received usually remains. We repeat again, that your apostolate should be without engaging in arguments; since you could become perplexed to the prejudice of all you have said, because perplexity prevents one from continuing to express oneself with serenity and clarity. Confusion could even take hold of you, because Satan utilizes any opportunity to confound the children of the





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
Church, above all by arguments with the children of darkness. The apostolate must always be carried out with integrity and serenity, expounding true doctrine and at the same time reproving false doctrine.

Regarding how to behave when out in the town and in places of sound recreation, We remind you, beloved children, of the obligation you have to be ever models in the way you dress and act, according to the Church's norms. The first apostolate of all should always be that of good example. Let everyone recognize you as disciples of Christ and children of the Holy Palmarian Church by your good deeds. Never give the children of darkness the opportunity to make fun of your Faith by your bad conduct, with the consequent discredit of Holy Church. Withdraw in time rather than put yourselves in danger of giving bad example. Avoid all occasions of scandal. You are obliged to do so; for otherwise, instead of apostolate, you would be carrying out the opposite, a destructive work, possibly irreparable. When you go into some shop, office, workshop, hospital and so forth, where the employees do not keep the Church norms referred to, you should limit yourselves to dealing with them only on matters relating to your visit. As you know, your dealings with those who do not dress correctly or live in concubinage, should be limited to a simple greeting (hello, good day, goodbye and so forth), without any other communication, and only when quite indispensable; for otherwise you should avoid every greeting. Regarding your oral apostolate on the street, places of sound recreation, shops, workshops and so forth, the same applies as previously said about schools, universities and places of work, as corresponds to them.

If for example someone in the street incorrectly dressed asks you for some information about the town, you should simply reply: "I can't tell you," and carry on your way. But if they ask you about your faith or about the church you belong to, you should valiantly reply: "I am from the Palmarian Catholic Church with See in El Palmar de Troya, Seville, Spain." If you find yourself truly in need of asking some information from a passer-by, and see nobody correctly dressed, you can ask such a person, always trying to choose the one who appears best dressed. We also remind you: Under pain of excommunication reserved to the Pope, Palmarian faithful are strictly forbidden any kind of communication with those who have apostatized from the Holy Palmarian Church, even with the apostolate in mind; as also any kind of communication with clergy or religious or lay theologians or others of similar or equivalent standing, belonging to any non-palmarian church. And when we say any kind of communication, greetings as well should be understood to be strictly forbidden.

O beloved children! Every day contact with the world is increasingly dangerous! The corruption is dizzying and humanly unstoppable. Only God can now put a stop to so much impiety and degeneration. Therefore Holy Mother Church, as Mother and Mistress, gives the remedy for avoiding contagion by the existent evil. The medicine is bitter, but efficacious. It does not mean avoiding contagion from a bodily disease, but from a pestilent and lethal spiritual and moral disease. The salvation of the soul is at stake. We must prevent at all costs that the children of the Church be contaminated, apostatize and damn themselves eternally. We know that you are judged by the world as though your were mad, as though you were senseless fools. We Palmarians are judged by people in the world on the basis of lies and calumnies. We are considered the dregs of society. But do not be troubled, so too was Christ judged and condemned by the apostate jewish hierarchs in union with the multitudinous mob which followed them and backed up the deicide. So do not be surprised that you too be judged and condemned in like manner. Look, Holy Mother Church, Catholic and Palmarian, was and continues to be persecuted by her enemies, who avail





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
themselves of lies and calumnies. Christ's Holy Church, just as was her Divine Founder, is today found crucified on Calvary, surrounded by enemies on all sides. But that is a very good sign. Following crucifixion and death, comes glorious resurrection. The triumph of the Palmarian Church is very close, but we must continue to strive for it, each of her members suffering the dolorous passion in imitation of Christ. Press on with resolve, beloved children, carrying the burdensome cross which has fallen to each to bear on his shoulders in the plan of salvation! Do not forget that We, Peter II, have the motto, "de Cruce Apocalyptica".

We, Pope Peter II, exhort all of you children of the Holy Palmarian Catholic Church, to foster more and more the Apostolate of Prayer. When your Missionary Bishop is away from the Palmarian Chapel which you usually attend, try to travel over to the Chapel where he will be celebrating Holy Worship, if it is not too far away and you have no great difficulty getting there. Try to encourage each other to do so in groups, so that the number attending will be greater. It is very important that, besides praying together in the bosom of each family, you all do everything possible to get together and pray in the Palmarian Chapel when the Missionary is not there, especially if the Most Blessed Sacrament is reserved. Community prayer, besides stimulating the spirit of prayer, strengthens the union between the children of the Church, since you all form a spiritual fellowship that should become ever firmer. Look, union makes for strength. However greater the union between you, less will be the power of Satan to combat you. We bring here moreover the following words of Christ: "For wherever two or three are gathered together in My Name, there I am in the midst of them." Be of good heart then, and foster the Apostolate of Prayer amongst you, the basis of the spiritual life of the members of the Church. Do not forget that prayer is man's strength and God's weakness. Pray always! The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak. Without constant prayer perseverance is not possible.

Beloved children: We repeat over again that your lives are marked with the glorious sign of the cross and the apostolate. You are the Apostles of the Cross, the Crossbearers, the war-seasoned Carmelite Tertiaries of the Holy Face who are to inflame the world with the fire of Christ's charity, which urges us on each day with greater demands. You are called to cover the earth with the dew of truth, so that new pastures take root there. You are called to cut out the cockle sown by the workers of iniquity, and grown thick, with your swords of prayer and penance. As apostles of Christ you should always be ready to propagate the seed of the gospel and defend it to heroism. We repeat over again: that your life be ever apostolic; that wherever your feet tread the ear of truth always grow up, so that its grains be scattered over the earth and the spiritual harvest be superabundant; that your testimony in favour of Christ and His Church be ever a constant element in your lives. Always take very much into account that your Catholic Faith is the light of the world, and that the light cannot be hidden, but has to shine out in the midst of the darkness, and that you should be ever disposed to defend it, even to the shedding of your last drop of blood. Look, according to Palmarian Church Law: "Under pain of excommunication reserved to the Pope, no one can hide or dissimulate his faith when there is an unavoidable obligation to confess it, even though he has well-founded fears that those hearing him may burst out in mockery or blasphemies against God and against holy things, and including when he is in danger of losing his life."

We, Pope Peter II, insist once more, with yet greater emphasis, that you press on each day firmer in your faith. For the time being you are winning the battle against Satan and all his hosts. But the evil one





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does not cease in his constant prowlings. The infernal serpent, that same one who overcame our first parents Adam and Eve in Paradise, carries on his seductive labour without respite. In these Apocalyptic Times, by divine permission, the devil dominates the world at his ease. Millions and millions are at his service. Only the children of the Palmarian Catholic Church remain for him to win to his cause. Though Satan well knows that Christ founded His Church upon the Immovable Rock of the Papacy, and that the gates of Hell will not prevail against Her, yet he knows that he can still draw down into apostasy those faithful who are not firm in the true faith, who are not constant in obedience to Church norms, and who do not wholeheartedly take up their arms to face up to him, namely prayer and penance. Look, dearest children, when the Infernal Dragon succeeds in trapping a member of Holy Church, only with difficulty will he let the prey go free. Oh yes, beloved children, those who apostatize fall ever deeper into the clutches of the devil! The pit of apostasy is very deep, and those who fall into it are unimaginably immersed in the darkness there, with little chance of getting out. For though God's graces will not be lacking to them, because of their sorry state they reject them and their ill thus results irremediable. So then, beloved Palmarian faithful, fidelity and steadfastness unto heroism! God has other very great favours prepared for those who persevere in this epoch of the Church in the Desert. Favours which have to be hard won by constant struggle. Perseverance, Palmarian faithful, perseverance! Trust in God's promises! Ask for the conversion of sinners, for things that seem impossible to men are possible to God.

Beloved Palmarian children, it only remains to tell you that in order for your apostolate to be efficacious, you should place it in the hands of the Most Holy Virgin Mary, Queen of the Apostles. She will inspire you how best to carry out the apostolic mission that corresponds to you in the world as faithful laypeople. Place yourselves trustingly in the arms of your Heavenly Mother, so that She protect you from the dangers involved in every apostolate. Trust in the Perpetual Succour of the Divine Mary and invoke her frequently, so that She guide you in the depths of your souls and you always tread with firm steps. Turn as well to Most Holy Joseph, whose protection is very powerful.

We, Peter II, have now given you some few instructions on your apostolate. We hope that none of you will wrongly interpret the meaning of Our words. We have firmly maintained the prohibitions of the Church regarding communication by the faithful with those outside of her, and at the same time We have tried to direct the most apt form for the lay apostolate within those prohibitions. Thus we make quite clear the obligation the Palmarian faithful have of doing apostolate in accord with the instructions of the Church.

Come, all Palmarian faithful, to the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya for the coming 16th of July, Principal Feast of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, Queen of Carmel and Universal Patroness!

On the sanctification of Sundays and other Holydays of obligation


We, Peter II, Sovereign Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of Palmar de Troya, *de Cruce Apocalýptica*, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We, by the present Apostolic Letter, call all faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, to come on pilgrimage to the Cathedral-Basilica for the occasion of the Most Solemn Worship on the 12th of October 2007, Principal Feast of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, Illuminatrix of the Holy Palmarian Council and of the Holy Palmarian Synod.

Beloved children, We commence Our epistolary message with the following words of Christ: "You, however, are those who have stood by Me in My sufferings. Accordingly, I place the Heavenly Kingdom at your disposal ..." Here, dearly beloved Palmarian faithful, is the Lord's great promise to His Apostles the day before His Passion and Death. By those words He left them Eternal Blessedness in Testament, which is the greatest treasure that, as a Good Father, He could leave to His children before dying. And that promise extends to all of us, as the faithful we are of the true Church, the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian, as the chosen children we are of God the Father, and therefore legitimate heirs to the heavenly throne won for us by His Divine Son Jesus Christ, King of kings, throne to which we have the right so long as we are faithful to the graces received and remain grafted onto the Mystical Body of Christ as living members. We, then, are children of God the Father and co-heirs with Christ; since if now we suffer with Him, afterwards we will be eternally glorified with Him.

See, beloved children, in the evangelical text quoted, Christ puts as condition for enjoying the Heavenly Kingdom one day, that of standing by Him in His sufferings, which entails generously taking part in His afflictions during the course of His Life on earth, which culminated with His Passion and Death on Calvary, in union with His Most Holy Mother, the Virgin Mary. There is no other way than that of docilely following along the way marked out by Our Divine Saviour. As the disciples that you are of Christ, if you aspire to enjoy His Kingdom, you must continue to take part in His sufferings, patiently enduring the weight of the cross that has fallen to each of you, ever disposed to shed your blood and die crucified. In truth, as Palmarians, you live crucified amidst a pagan world, amidst a corrupt society where only material things have value, where wellbeing and pleasure in their multiple varieties and aberrations are considered the only objects of man's aspirations. Your crucifixion is, precisely, with the nails of incomprehension by all those servants of the world who consider you crazy, heretics, demoniacs and deserving of the greatest





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




contempt. But do not be discouraged by this. Our Lord Jesus Christ too was victim of the most iniquitous persecution, fostered by the jewish church hierarchy and seconded by the immense crowds, who rejected the Gospel Law because of its total incompatibility with their depraved morals. And if Christ was rejected and persecuted, you also, His true disciples, have to be rejected and persecuted for that same reason, because the Palmarian Church is bearer of the Catholic Faith and Morals in accord with Gospel demands. Indeed, beloved children, the true Church of Christ, today the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian, is rejected and vilified for teaching the true Christian Doctrine, for exacting conduct wholly subject to Divine Law. That is why we Palmarians are uncomfortable to the society we live in, as Christ was to that jewish people who sentenced Him to an ignominious death.

But note, beloved children, besides the world and Satan with his underlings, there is an enemy of the soul that always accompanies it: our own flesh. Therefore, our crucifixion with Christ is as well the constant struggle everyone must keep up with himself. Each of you is burdened with his own flesh, inclined to sin ever since Adam's prevarication. And this enemy of the soul, which is the flesh, tortures with the sting of concupiscent appetites, and so as not to fall under slavery to sin it is crucial to do it violence, thus to enjoy the liberty of the sons of God united to Christ and Mary on Calvary, in continuous struggle, renouncing all that might separate you from the life of grace. You must remain ever crucified with the nails of constant self-denial, mortifying your flesh, repressing your worldly sentiments, discarding vain desires, in short, embracing the Cross of Christ through the generous, heroic and selfless acceptance of the cross which is the lot of each to carry.

O beloved children: For those who truly love God, for those who ardently love the Cross of Christ, the sufferings of this life, however acute they may appear, are sweetened by the gentle and most fragrant balm emanating from that same love. Suffering, united to the love of God, sanctifies and at the same time showers with heavenly consolation whoever generously immolates himself, since it alleviates the arduous thirst for souls felt by Christ in His agony. You are fulfilling the mission of Christ's Cyrenians in this world, the mission of Veronicas of the Lord's Face. And you must do so with generosity, with heroism and above all with love. O, the love of God! If you were to penetrate deeper into the greatness of divine love...! For love of God, the innumerable Saints who people the heavenly mansions were capable of the greatest exploits in order to extend the Kingdom of Christ. For love of God, martyrs without number did not shrink from suffering the cruelest torments and shedding their blood magnanimously. For love of God, the Mystical Doctress and Reformatrix of Carmel, Saint Teresa of Jesus, earnestly exclaimed: "Lord, to suffer or to die!" Love God, beloved children. Love God to folly. Oh, that for the love of God the children of the Church be models of virtue. But the love of God does not consist only in words or mere sentiments, but has to be manifested as well with supernatural works through the life of grace. Live, then, in the love of God, each of you carrying out your obligations with the greatest uprightness, so that when those of the world see you they say: "Look, they have gone mad for the love of God." One day, when by infinite divine mercy you attain Eternal Blessedness, perfect love of God will satisfy all your yearnings, because the Kingdom of Heaven is the Dwelling-place of Love. There, all is love of God and neighbour, as it is the homeland of most perfect charity, the virtue that will last eternally. Ah, if you would love God to delirium...! Ask the Most Holy Virgin Mary to fill you with the love of God, to inundate you, to immerse you, so that your life be only love of God, and love of neighbour for love of God.






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





But true love of God requires a knowledge ever more complete of His Holy Doctrine and of Holy Morals. There is an obligation to know, as far as possible, all that is necessary for the fulfilment of religious, moral and social duties, and thus move on ahead towards the supernatural last end which is eternal salvation. Palmarian Catholic religious and moral formation is indeed necessary in order that your conduct be ever in accord with divine plans, just as Holy Mother Church teaches. O beloved Palmarians, you are so highly privileged! While sin, darkness and error rule in the world, you, as faithful of the true Church, are possessors of Grace, Light and Truth. The Great Supernatural Gift, which is the Holy Ghost, dwells in your souls in the state of grace. You have at your disposal the means of sanctification given by Christ Himself to His Church, which are, principally, the Holy Sacrifice of Mass and the Holy Sacraments. At your disposal you have the admirable doctrinal teaching that God, Our Lord, kept in reserve for these Last Times. You are possessors of the greatest treasure of wisdom to which man can aspire in this world, since in your hands are: the Word of God, magisterially revealed, without errors or ambiguities, in the book par excellence, which is the Holy Palmarian Bible in its different grades, with its magisterial summary of the Treatise on the Most Blessed Trinity; the true Faith and Catholic Morals contained in the Palmarian Creed, in the Catechism in its three grades, in the Treatise on the Mass and in the Papal Documents, books which you all also have in your homes. Yes indeed, beloved children, you are highly privileged. Only within the Holy Palmarian Church is that privilege possible, is salvation possible, since outside of Her there is nothing that can lead to the supernatural end of Man: eternal Blessedness.

We, Pope Peter II, exhort you, urge you, require of you, beloved children, that you be ever more faithful to God's privileges, responding to His extraordinary gifts with gratitude, loyalty and generosity. Withdraw yourselves from all that is offensive to God. While it is true that you are weak by nature, nonetheless you can count on divine grace, fortifying and vivifying, with which you can overcome if you respond to it. Ever reflect that God, the Almighty, works supernaturally in souls docile to His Holy Will. And though you are nothing and can do nothing of yourselves, by the help of God you will not only prevail over weakness and sin, but will succeed in reaching unimaginable heights of virtue and sanctity. Beloved children, in the brevity of this exile, live entirely for God. Make use of material things only in what is absolutely necessary to serve God with rectitude, with decency and with entire fidelity to His divine plans. However beautiful and appetizing the things of the world may seem to you, none of them will ever be able fully to satisfy your aspirations. Look what the great Doctor of the Church, Saint Augustine says: "You have made us for Yourself, O Lord, and our hearts will not rest until they rest in You." Complete happiness for us is in Heaven where we will possess God eternally. As regards this world as well, only in God is the happiness here possible attained, though always very limited, being inseparably united to pain, to struggle, to the cross of each; though enlivened by the hope of attaining it one day in Heaven in all fullness. Outside of God, the vain happiness the world offers is like a cloud of smoke that swathes and then fades away, as it does not lead to the supernatural end of man which is Eternal Blessedness, the definitive homeland, rest without end, happiness utterly sated.

But lamentably, dearly beloved Palmarians: How often, the children of the Church themselves, by their imprudence, prepare the way for Satan to act! Meditate on what the Lord said: "Be then intelligent as serpents, and simple as doves." Do not give occasion for the enemies of your faith to control you, to use you, to undo you. Do not given them occasion. Lately, without permission from the Holy See, in

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Germany a booklet with all kinds of personal details, some of them quite private, both of the Apostolic See, as well as of faithful of the Church, has been edited and distributed among the faithful of several dioceses. Besides, this booklet, at least the copy We have seen, has a cover with the same format as if it had been published in this Holy See. What imprudence, beloved children! We believe that this has been done without malice, but We have no remedy other than to admonish the authors and distributors. Do you realize the danger if that booklet should fall into the hands of others, into enemy hands...! One thing is to note down telephones and other items privately in a pad, things that may be necessary for professional, family, friendship and apostolic reasons. But what has been printed and handed out, though only amongst the faithful, is a rash undertaking. Thank God We came to know about it in time so as to remedy the matter without delay. Therefore, beloved children, We gave the order that those booklets were to be taken back immediately from those who had them and sent to this Holy See, and that all data be removed from computers as well. All this We ordered under pain of excommunication reserved to Us. No Missionary Bishop or Palmarian faithful is authorized to keep a copy for their use. Each missionary already has with him a notebook with addresses and telephones edited here, for his exclusive use on his apostolic mission, since it is intransferable to the faithful. Be more prudent, beloved Palmarians. With the world as it is, no one should act lightly, but with every precaution.

Dearest children of the Church: use your free time to instruct yourselves further in the truths of the Catholic Faith and in the norms of Holy Morals. It is indispensable for you to read and reread, with unction, the Holy Palmarian Bible and the other publications in your possession. You have more than sufficient material for holy reading. Meditate intimately on the life of Our Lord Jesus Christ and that of His Most Holy Mother the Virgin Mary. May all who see you, on observing your conduct, say that you are perfect imitators of Christ and Mary. Read too the life of Most Holy Joseph and of other saints, as related in the Palmarian publications you possess. If you do not learn from the lives of the saints, how are you going to imitate their virtues? The Saints loved Christ and Mary with delirium, served them with generosity, followed their footsteps with heroic deference to the divine will, and arranged their lives so that God might make use of them for His salvific plans. With holy reading joined to prayer, you will penetrate deeper into the divine mysteries, into heavenly wisdom, and will attain greater spiritual fortitude. Prayer and meditation are the basis of the spiritual life. Prayer and meditation will invigorate you so that the true spirit of austerity and penance reign in you. Prayer and meditation will teach you the way to sanctity. O beloved children, how many Saints have passed from the greatest ignorance to possession of very high grades of wisdom, thanks to prayer and meditation!

See, beloved children, Sundays and any other Holydays of obligation are very suitable for dedicating yourselves more especially to spiritual reading. Make use of those days to season your souls with the word of God, delighting yourselves in the charming biblical passages, especially the Holy Gospel. Going over the publications you possess, you will instruct yourselves further in Palmarian doctrine and morals. O beloved Palmarians, saturate yourselves with Truth! Permeate yourselves ever more with the divine wisdom that is possible on earth! Let Sundays and other Holydays of obligation be for you like a comforting and wholesome oasis amidst the aridity of the desert of daily life. It is necessary that you be more responsible towards the sanctification of Sunday. According to Holy Palmarian Morals, for the sanctification of Sundays and other Holydays of obligation, God requires that man rest from his labours on these





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days, with the aim of permitting him to consecrate them to divine worship, to the sanctification of his own soul, to the children, to perform works of charity and of apostolate, and as well to healthy recreation. All this also redounds in a greater corporal and intellectual rest, so necessary to be able to face up to religious and professional duties in succeeding days. In the beginning of the world, the Most High established the first day of the week or Sunday as a Holyday especially consecrated to divine worship. In the Holy Palmarian Catechism are listed the Holydays which, as well as Sundays, are of rigorous obligation, some established previously and others later by the Palmarian Church; and listed too are the obligations for these days which must be fulfilled in all rectitude. You have the Holydays as well in the Palmarian Calendar. If anyone needs further clarification he should ask the Palmarian Church Hierarchy.

In these times, however, some traditional Holydays of obligation have disappeared from calendars of the world or are considered as working days. In this manner, the way has been opened up also to establish more pagan holidays. And as God and His Holy Law are in no way respected, on those Holydays they continue to work at their various professional and commercial jobs, profaning in this way the sanctification of those days. We understand that there are Holydays in the Palmarian Calendar on which you are unable to fulfil the obligatory rest, since you are obliged to work in offices, businesses and commercial centres where those Holydays are neither acknowledged nor respected. In this case you have no other option but to fulfil your working obligations, since otherwise you would find yourselves out of work. A different matter is when a Palmarian faithful is the owner of a company or business; since in that case there is the obligation under pain of grievous sin to observe the rest established by God and by the Church, both yourselves and your employees, whether or not they are Palmarians. And when you make some business contract, work on Sundays and other Holydays of obligation must always be excluded. It is also forbidden for you, Palmarian faithful, under pain of grievous sin, to enter commercial centres or other shops forbidden by the Church on those days, or collaborate directly or indirectly with those businesses. When you go out on Sundays and other Holydays of obligation and find commercial centres and other shops open, keep on your way as if they were closed, for in truth they are closed to you, as you are forbidden to enter them. We again repeat: You cannot collaborate either directly or indirectly in any type of work forbidden on Sundays and other Holydays of obligation.

According to Holy Palmarian Morals, occupations forbidden on Sundays and other Holydays of obligation are: corporal, mechanical and industrial labour, whether remunerative or not, for example: factory work, mining, bricklaying, carpentry, metalwork, shoemaking, tailoring, farming and so forth; intellectual work for remunerative ends, for example: legal work, court work, university work, scientific work, teaching, administrative work, of public officials, notarial work, medical treatment not absolutely necessary and so on; mercantile work, for example: shops, markets, stores etc.; housework not absolutely necessary.

According to Holy Palmarian Morals, the kinds of work permitted on Sundays and other Holydays of obligation are: work directly related to divine worship, for example: adorning a church, preparing a procession or any other similar act, etc.; but work only indirectly related is not permitted, for example: reparation of a chapel and such like; work related to charity, for example: visiting, taking care of and relieving the sick, helping the poor, burying the dead, propagation of the faith or other apostolate, and so forth; work necessary for the good of society: in hospitals, bakeries, restaurants, transport (trains, buses,





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taxis...), fire brigades, security services and the like; housework that is absolutely necessary for the good order and wellbeing of the family, for example: cooking, cleaning, washing, ironing and so on; work involved in the necessary care of animals; work to avoid imminent danger on farms or other properties that cannot be put off, for example: the farmer faced with the imminence of a great storm, goes out to the fields and brings in everything in danger of being lost; sheer recreation, like reading, writing, artistic painting or sculpture, hunting, fishing, recreative gardening, touring and so forth; and other work with the tacit or express licence of the Church.

Beloved children, in case you need some clarification, ask the Palmarian Church Hierarchy. And nothing more for now.

Come all, Palmarian faithful, to the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya for the forthcoming 12th of October, Feast of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, Illuminatrix of the Holy Palmarian Council and of the Holy Palmarian Synod!


We, Peter II, Supreme Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of El Palmar de Troya, *de Cruce Apocalyptica*, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We, by the present Apostolic Letter, make a new calling to all the faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church to come on pilgrimage to the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya on the occasion of New Year's Eve 2007 and New Year's Day 2008, thus to participate in the Solemn Worship which, God willing, will be celebrated in the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar.

Beloved children, this end-of-the-year pilgrimage must be considered as of singular importance, being the start of Holy Year 2008 convoked by Us to commemorate, on the 30th of next March, the Fortieth Anniversary of the First Apparition of the Most Holy Virgin Mary in the Sacred Place of the Lentisco, where today Her Sacred Image is honoured. During these four decades, great, sublime and supernatural events have taken place in the Blessed Grounds where the Mother of God deigned to place Her Purest Feet in order to transmit Her message of salvation to the world. Thanks to the astonishing Marian Apparitions of El Palmar de Troya, Holy Mother Church continues unscathed her most lofty saving mission, deposited by Christ in the person of Pope Saint Peter. This is most evident proof that the gates of Hell shall never prevail against the Church, in keeping with the promise given by her Divine Founder.

The Glorious Grounds of the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, and at the same time Mystical Desert, is today the See of the true Church, Ark of Salvation, Barque of Peter, directed first by the vigorous hands of Our Revered Predecessor, Pope Saint Gregory XVII the Very Great, and at the present by Us, Peter II, his successor in the Papacy. As you can see, the Blessed Apparitions, occurring over long years, culminated in the translation of the See of the Church from Rome to El Palmar de Troya. 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

Eternal salvation is only here, in the Holy Palmarian Church, ruled by Us, Peter II, Vicar of Christ, Legitimate Successor of Saint Peter. Christ Our Lord hermetically closes the Gates of Eternal Happiness to those refusing to pass through the Visible Door, namely the Pope. We again repeat to the world: Let no one be deceived! The Pope is in the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, and We, Peter II, are Pope by the grace of God.

Dearly beloved children: The Palmarian Creed, sublime compendium of Catholic Doctrine, states in all rotundity; "I believe that the True Church of Christ is indefectible, invincible and indestructible by the very promise of her Divine Founder." The miraculous indestructibility of the Church is an evident and unquestionable fact, however much Satan's underlings seek to deny it. No one has ever been able or will be able to overcome the true Church of Christ, however powerful and fierce her enemies may be. Yet it is true that Holy Church has been the victim of cruel and ferocious assaults over the centuries. From Saint Peter on, a great number of Popes have generously given their lives in defence of Catholic Orthodoxy and of their Legitimate and Supreme Authority, both Spiritual and Temporal. The martyrs of Christianity are countless: clerics, religious and laity, who heroically shed their blood amid the cruellest torments, to defend their Faith with unfailing integrity. Also innumerable are the children of the Church who, without shedding their blood, were victims of degrading ill-treatment, persecutions, humiliations, calumnies and other types of oppression. The Church of Christ, however, vitalized yet further by suffering, continues on victorious with her gaze fixed on the future apostolate, without looking back, ever firm in the divine mission Christ entrusted to her; whereas her enemies go crashing up against the wall of their own iniquities.

Observe, beloved children, the apostate Jewish people who rejected Christ; they, who had the effrontery to crucify Him ignominiously knowing that He was the Son of God, and who resolved to do away with Christianity, have fallen by the wayside, while Holy Church, assisted and fortified by the Holy Ghost, continued on with her loftiest and fruitful mission of preaching the Gospel throughout the world. What is to be said of that powerful Roman Empire, which made a show of being invincible, dominating, and civilized? While it is true that those despotic, idolatrous and corrupt emperors, with their large armies were able to bend many peoples to their yoke, yet they could never subject the Church, since the very blood of the martyrs rose up vigorously to confound her oppressors and scatter the germinating seed of new Christians. And so the proverb always came true: "The blood of martyrs is the seed of new Christians." And what remains of that Imperial Rome? Nothing! A few miserable traces! Her power and her idols plummeted down; and over the dust of her proud edifices, sumptuous Temples of Christianity were later raised. And what shall we say of the numerous heretics and schismatics who have tried to undermine the Church of Christ with the aim of toppling her from her unshakable foundations? They too fell by the wayside of eternal salvation, into Satan's clutches, nourishing themselves on the filth of their errors, since they despised the deifying nourishment of true doctrine. And the same can be said of all the other uncountable persecutions the Church has suffered throughout history. And notwithstanding, the Church, immutable, unconquered and fruitful, ever continued her saving mission, and with great Saints, whose radiant aureoles eclipse the false and grimy flicker of those who dared seek to bring her down. And what can be said of the apostate roman church? Her stars fell moved by the hurricanes of progressivism, of heresy, of licentiousness and of masonic scheming. Her pompous churches are now nests of impiety.





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
After the general apostasy, they were left with the husk, and we, the Palmarians, conserve the true Faith, the authentic doctrine and holy discipline. Dearly beloved faithful, in the present times, amidst a turbulent, tenebrous, corrupt ocean of ambitions in power and armaments, you can see how the Barque of Peter, today the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, passes over the impetuous waves, indefectible, invincible and indestructible, always looking ahead without vacillating, since Christ Himself sustains and directs the arm of His Vicar on earth, Ourself, Peter II, so that the promise of the Divine Founder be thus fulfilled: "The gates of Hell shall not prevail against Her."

Beloved children of Our Papal Heart: All those who apostatise from the true Faith, on separating from the Mystical Body of Christ, are left outside, scattered either to one side or the other of the path to eternal salvation; without any right to the inheritance promised to the children of God, as long as they do not return to the fold of the Church. That is an unquestionable reality. Let apostates not waste time miserably seeking other ways to follow. Let them not try to justify their attitude alleging untenable reasons. To them We reply with the selfsame words of Christ: "Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice." And the voice of Christ is the voice of the Church, the voice of His Vicar on earth, and those who disregard the divine teachings of the Church, are not of the truth, however many reasons they may give in defence of their erroneous stand. The Truth is One, as the Church founded by Our Lord Jesus Christ is One. Outside the true Church confusion and error reign. Either with the Church of Christ, or with the church of Satan. There are no half measures. O beloved children, when the darkness of obstinacy densely envelops the human mind, how difficult it is for light to penetrate into the interior of the heart; especially when truth was previously possessed and later disregarded. It should not be forgotten that it was pride and disobedience that plunged Lucifer and his followers to the depths of Hell: They wanted to be like God, and so they refused to obey God.

That is why you, beloved Palmarian children, as children of the authentic Catholic Church, are bearers of the true Faith. And not only must you conduct yourselves as such, but you have the additional unavoidable duty to save souls by your prayers and sacrifices. Cast out of your lives any tendency to convenience that might separate you from the loftiest apostolic mission which, as militant Christians, is incumbent upon you to fulfil. Let none of you be complacent in egoistic passivity. No one is saved or damned alone, since sanctity begets sanctity and impiety begets impiety. If in truth you earnestly seek the sanctification of your souls, you must seek the salvation of others with the same impetus. Everything is possible to God. You should never consider as definitively lost the souls of those sinners who appear to you gone far astray and quite hardened. You yourselves, without seeing the fruits for the moment, are saving many souls through your prayers, sacrifices and the testimony of your virtues; since your good works carried out in the grace of God are finite sacrifices, which, united by the Celebrating Priest to the Infinite Sacrifice of Christ and Mary in the Holy Sacrifice of Mass, acquire infinite reparative and redemptive value.

O beloved children: You possess the pearl of great price that Christ speaks of in the Gospel parable. This pearl is your Palmarian Faith, it is Sanctifying Grace dwelling in your souls, it is the holy ambition to sanctify yourselves ever more, it is the desire to recruit souls for the Kingdom of Christ, it is the religious and priestly vocation for those called to the state of perfection in religious life. And this pearl of great price must be valued and conserved until death; and in the measure that it shines forth, so will be





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


your eternal recompense. You must never let this pearl of great price which you possess by the mercy of God fall to the ground and be trodden on by the unclean beasts of heresy, vice and obstinacy in sin. Take great care of that pearl, lest Satan, envious of your status as children of God, snatch it from you. Bear well in mind that the infernal serpent is astute and intelligent, and scrutinizes your acts; and has innumerable henchmen at his service as well, above all in these Last Times. Alas! Beloved Palmarians, sadly how often do some of you, children of the Light, possessing efficacious means to overcome, let yourselves be easily sifted by the tactics of the soul's enemies. Struggle on bravely, children of the Church, and do not let yourselves be enslaved. Courageously defend your legitimate rights as Christians, without wavering, without fear. Note with what brazen despotism the children of darkness impose on the world their erroneous criteria, their licentious morality, their depraved fashions, their covetous plans, without being in the least concerned that God is grievously offended, that so many souls fall every day into the depths of hell. Their only concerns are the accumulation of wealth, pleasures, wellbeing, the ambition of power and other worldly interests.

Dearly beloved children: Let everyone prepare with pious enthusiasm to welcome Palmarian Holy Year 2008. It will be a year of abundant graces for those who have recourse to the Infinite Mercy of God, Our Lord, who never ceases to give us a multitude of opportunities to raise ourselves up from falls, to strengthen ourselves in weakness, to purify ourselves and, in short, so that we can attain sanctity. How many graces are received during Holy Years! How many souls in the world are saved thanks to the most faithful response of the children of the Church gaining Most Plenary Indulgences! They are graces which you should make the most of with holy ambition for your own welfare and that of others. Do not squander them! Try to come to this Holy Apostolic See of the Church, not only on Official Pilgrimages, but on other days as well throughout the year, since the indulgences of Holy Year 2008 can only be gained in the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar. Arrange the means, always taking into account that what is impossible for men is possible for God. It is the Most Holy Virgin Mary who calls you through Us. Vicar of Christ, and She will help you. Make good use of the graces of this Holy Year. You need them in order to be fortified for future events, as the day is at hand when God will let His Holy Wrath fall upon the world. Men live with their backs to their Creator, scorning His Supreme Authority, overruling His Holy Law; so, just as happened at the Universal Flood, the deluge of fire which is inevitably going to fall upon humanity will catch the world unawares. Everything will be purified, everything! The world's corruption has filled the vessel of divine indignation to overflowing. It only remains for God's Wrath to fall with the just violence that the gravity and multitude of sins deserve.

O beloved children: Foment ever more in your souls the love of God and of neighbour for love of God. Be zealous imitators of Christ and Mary in Charity. Live with firmness and authenticity the Catholic Faith you profess. To do so you must generously correspond to God's plans, each according to his state in life, faithfully keeping the Divine Law and the dispositions of the Church. Meditate on the following exhortation of the Holy Ghost contained in the Book of Ecclesiasticus: "Fulfil the Law of God without haggling, and you will not go astray, since in it no lie at all exists; for perfect Wisdom resides in faithful fulfilment of the Law." And that perfect Wisdom is the life of grace in the soul, supernatural charity, true love of God, which will attain its fullness of perfection in Eternal Blessedness. O beloved children: God's precepts enlighten man's understanding, consolidate his virtue and deify his soul with






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
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divine love. Supernatural life of soul lies in the possession and practice of the Holy Law, and therefore in the possession and practice of the Love of God. As Christ Himself teaches us, the Divine Commandments are contained in the first and greatest of them all, namely to love God and one's neighbour. Whoever breaks any of the Commandments breaks the entire Law, since he commits an outrage against the love of God, without which supernatural life in the soul is not possible. Whoever breaks a single Commandment of His Law does not love God, though he fulfil all the rest. That is why man can damn himself equally for one mortal sin as for many, because mortal sin expels from the soul the Holy Ghost, Who is the Personification of Triune Love, making way there for Satan who is the personification of hatred for God. O dearest children, God hates the soul in mortal sin; and this hatred is absolutely necessary in Him, as sin opposes His Infinite Sanctity. The Merciful God, however, continues giving His graces to the soul so that it forsake that lamentable situation, if it responds to them, since He desires that all be saved.

We, Pope Peter II, desire to begin Palmarian Holy Year 2008 by inaugurating the monumental statues of Christ the King, of Mary Queen, of Saint Joseph Protector of Holy Church, and of Saint Gregory XVII the Very Great, in the great esplanade in front of the Cathedral Temple. The blessing of the images, God willing, will be at midnight, coinciding with the peal of bells that ushers in the beginning of the New Year. Firstly, We wish to highlight, in the measure that is humanly possible, the Imperial Royalty of Christ and Mary, who truly reign on this Sacred Mount of Christ the King, so that soon the Reign of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary may extend over the entire orb. We humbly beseech the Eternal Father to hasten the hour of the apotheosic glorification of Holy Palmarian Church, for the welfare of souls. We implore Christ and Mary that Their Most Sacred Blood shed on Calvary, and shed unbloodily in each Sacrifice of Mass with substantial graces and conversions, soon, in the sight of all men, in an evident and extraordinary form, manifest their saving efficacy through a flood of conversions, to the greater glory of God and exaltation of Holy Palmarian Church. We vehemently desire that sinful humanity, sincerely repentant, soon turn back to the Eternal Father seeking mercy and pardon. Secondly, We wish to highlight, in the measure that is humanly possible, the perpetual patronage of Most Holy Joseph over the Church, and to implore him as well to shelter all his children in a most special way in the present and future combats from Satan and his underlings. And thirdly, We desire to exalt the glorious memory of Our Revered Predecessor Pope Saint Gregory XVII the Very Great, and render him homage of love and gratitude for his most faithful and heroic labour in the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya and in Holy Church, as Seer, Bishop Primate and Supreme Pontiff.

Beloved children: the solemn feast of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ approaches, a beloved feast which you must live in close union with the Holy Family. During Christmas, may your homes be a resemblance of that Cave of Bethlehem divinized by the exalted Mystery of the Birth of the Son of God. Meditate on the sublime family life of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, most faithfully fulfilling the mission entrusted to them by the Eternal Father. Sanctify the feast of Christmas, live it with the greatest spirituality possible. Celebrate it with wholesome merriment. Let your homes be an oasis of love, peace and heavenly joy. Sanctity is not at variance with joy. Supernatural virtue generates holy joy, precisely because sanctity comes from God, and God is Infinite Joy. Saint Teresa of Jesus used to say that a sad Saint is a sorry Saint. What a great truth! Happiness is not at odds with austerity of life, or with sacrifice, or with suffering or with renunciation, or with anything done or offered for love of God. Look, Our Lord Jesus Christ, after





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recriminating the attitude of the hypocrites who disfigured their faces and looked sad so as to be praised for their penances, said to the multitude listening to Him: "You, on the contrary, when you fast, appear cheerful and normal, so that men do not know you are fasting, but only your Heavenly Father." O beloved children of Our Papal Heart: from the practice of virtue springs wholesome joy, true joy, fruit of the divine joy of the soul in the State of Grace. A corrupt life, on the contrary, produces interior bitterness and false joy.


Dearest Palmarian faithful: In the measure possible to you, place the traditional Crib or Nativity scene in your homes, which will serve as an incentive for you to live more fervently the feast of the Nativity of the Lord. Separate yourselves from all those symbols and customs that profane it, introduced by rampant paganism so as to banish Holy Tradition, falsify truth and counteract the authentic religious spirit of the Christmas feast. According to Palmarian Ecclesiastical Law, incur excommunication reserved to the Pope: "Whoever sets up a Christmas tree or participates in any way with one. Whoever gives or receives a present in memory of the Birth of the Lord at Christmas, since the proper day for such gifts is the 6th of January, festivity of the Epiphany of the Lord, in commemoration of the gifts of gold, incense and myrrh offered by the Three Wise Kings of Orient to the Child Jesus. Whoever takes part in any way in the protestant custom of Father Christmas. Whoever takes part in any way in the fable or masquerade of the gifts of Saint Nicholas. Whoever takes part in any way in the arrival at the front door of the Three Wise Kings of Orient, in order to put three crosses on the door with their initials and receive a stipend for the apostate roman church. Whoever on the 6th of January puts on their front door three crosses with the initials of the Three Wise Kings of Orient." 





Make sure that Palmarian Holy Year 2008 mark the beginning of a new life for you in the spiritual order.

We, Peter II, as Universal Father of the Church, again urge all religious and tertiary members of the Order of Carmelites of the Holy Face in Company of Jesus and Mary to continue on in the service of God and of the Church with generous and heroic purpose, giving testimony before the world by your life of piety that you are in possession of the true Catholic Faith. Do not look back, nor waver! Keep on forever ahead, valiantly, courageously, enthusiastically, with the holy ambition of conquering the world for Christ. Palmarian Apostles: continue ever forward, with the full assurance that Christ and Mary are leading you on in the struggle, and that you are not alone. Bear ever in mind the maxim of the glorious Reformatrix of Carmel, Saint Teresa of Jesus, who in moments of fierce conflict, used to cry out: "Christ and myself, a









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
majority". She was one of the great pillars that upheld the edifice of the religious life, and therefore the spirituality of the Church, in those devastating times of corruption, laxity and ruin brought about by the heresiarch presbyter and augustinian friar Martin Luther, and Satan's other accursed agents.

Consider, beloved religious and tertiary children, Carmelites of the Holy Face: in this hour of the power of darkness, you are the ones chosen by God, the apple of the Heavenly Father's eye, the Church's glorious expectation. You are the bearers of the Supernatural Life emanating from the Holy Face of Our Lord Jesus Christ and from the Sacred Image of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar who preside the Unshakeable Column of the Lentisco of El Palmar de Troya. In a word, you are the Apostles of the Last Times, the Crossbearers, the bearers of the Cross of Redemption. As the children you are of Holy Palmarian Church, you carry out the extraordinary mission of preparing the way for the Glorious Second Coming of Christ, which is very near. Hence you are the precursors of this transcendental event, in union with Us, Pope Peter II. Your responsibility is great indeed, dearest children, more than some of you think! You have set your hand to the plough, committed yourselves to work the land spiritually, to dress it and make it fertile by the sweat of your sacrifices, your prayers and your generous commitment to the service of God and of the Church.

O beloved children! The times in which you live are far worse than those which befell Saint Teresa of Jesus to live through. Today heresy, depravity and destruction are on a universal scale. Only the members of the Palmarian Church are still on their feet, uphold the true Catholic Faith and Holy Tradition, and maintain Religious Life intact. Accordingly, beloved in Christ, your mission is to restore the world morally and supernaturally, thus making straight the ways for Christ's Apotheosic Coming as precursors you are, with the aim that many turn their eyes to the truth and receive contrite the Supreme Judge. To achieve the world's restoration, you, as children of the Church, must needs scatter the seed of spiritual regeneration, of which you are depositaries by the grace of God. Enliven this good seed in your hearts, seek the Kingdom of God and His justice with burning eagerness, so that the face of the earth be soon renewed.

O beloved children! How consoling are those words of Christ spoken in the Sermon on the Mount: "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after justice, for they shall have their fill." The supreme goal has always to be holiness. As you know, those who hunger and thirst after justice are they who yearn for and endeavour to obtain holiness for themselves and for others. Hunger and thirst for holiness is based on the possession of God, in the generous surrender to God's Will, in detachment from all that can separate us from intimate union with Him, union which is only possible by means of the life of grace. The eager desire for sanctity, which wells up from the soul by virtue of her sacred espousal with Christ and Mary, is a fount whose flow continuously increases according to the measure of our collaboration with the divine plan for our sanctification. This appetite for sanctity is spurred on by the Holy Ghost, the Divine Guest who divinizes and vivifies the soul. When a soul gives herself up generously to God, her desire of perfection grows day by day, and becomes including irresistible from the ardent desire to serve and love Him more and more. The love of God is like a little flame, tiny, which from contact with the impetuous fire of the Divine Paraclete, keeps on growing without any other goal than that of living ever more inflamed by the infinite flame of that Divine Love. And We say that it becomes irresistible, since hunger and thirst for God, for those who serve Him generously, is insatiable as long as we live in this poor exile. Only in






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
Heaven will that supernatural appetite be fully satisfied and contented by virtue of the perfect charity that floods each blessed soul in the measure of merits gained on earth.

It is surely true, beloved children, that along the way of virtue you find yourselves assailed by three fierce brigands: the world, the devil and the flesh, who at any price seek to snatch away the treasure of your holy aspirations and form within you a state of despondency, so that you abandon your heroic undertaking. But by the grace of God, you will overcome these obstacles, keeping ever on the watch and in continuous battle. Along the way of your sanctification, take care never to linger and listen to the barking of the fierce dogs coming out to confront you. Keep on your way with steadfast spirit, since such obstacles, permitted by God, are to make your struggle against the power of darkness more meritorious and remunerative in Eternal Life. Let no one think therefore that holiness is an inaccessible peak. Christ Himself tells us: "Be then perfect, as your Heavenly Father is perfect." Consequently all are able to go on up by the luminous stairway of perfection, with the help of grace and personal collaboration. Holiness. beloved children, is within your reach, according to your state of life. In religious life there are greater possibilities for personal sanctification; but you who live in the world also count on sufficient means to be able to reach high peaks of perfection. Once again We repeat that the life of a Palmarian faithful is a vocation to sanctity, and is a serious and unavoidable commitment to God. As children of the Palmarian Church you are faced with the duty to become saints. The Holiness of the Church to which you belong itself presses you on.

Beloved Palmarian faithful: let your hearts remain ever pure and perfectly ordered. Act in an irreproachable way. Never give occasion for scandal by your conduct. "Abstain from all semblance of evil", as Apostle Saint Paul teaches. Let the divine sonship you possess by the indwelling of the Holy Ghost in your souls be ever discerned in your actions. Let your outward bearing be ever a vivid reflection of your inward sanctity. Meditate on the following words of Christ: "Blessed are the clean of heart, for they shall see God." As you know, those who live in the state of grace and conduct themselves with the required mortification and purity of conscience, are the clean of heart. O beloved children! Cultivate the soil of your soul with tender care so that there never be found therein the least shade of any possible cockle. Be alert to the voice of your conscience when it reproaches you for something, and cleanse yourselves as soon as you can. Turn frequently to the Sacrament of Confession, including when you feel no culpability for any mortal sin; for though there is truly no obligation to confess venial sins, it is very advisable to do so. Furthermore, you lay faithful should endeavour to make a general confession at least once a year, for the purpose of keeping your soul in the best possible order. By general confession the soul settles accounts with God when aware of some confession badly made, or some other matter left pending in the course of past life. By general confession, many doubtful matters causing unease in the soul are settled. General confession also contributes to greater purification and expiation of soul for sins previously forgiven. Besides, general confession concluded, the Priest imparts the Papal Blessing with Plenary Indulgence to the penitent. Practice general confession at least once a year, unless you need to do so more often, and you will see the great benefits of this pious practice.

Beloved children of Our Papal Heart: never have anything to do with those who do evil. Freemasonry governs the world with the sagacity of darkness, setting up its satanic contrivances so that society be forever enveloped in the kind of climate that most favours their impious aims. Satan's followers manipulate





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
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everything at their ease, and ungodliness is the air one breathes. Take care, great care, beloved children! Flee from contamination and live in the world without taking any part in the depravities of the world. Sadly, in spite of Our warnings in a previous Apostolic Letter, some Palmarians were living enthralled by the infernal music abounding today, which spreads about like clouds of insects, invading everything. The times we live in are not only of moral corruption, but also of cultural decadence in every aspect. Child and youth educational systems are in their immense majority opposed to sound morals, good taste and true art. For example, accursed rock music with all the different varieties emanating from it, is the music which today predominates in every social environment. What is worse is that an immense mass of men and women of all ages give it a warm welcome. Satanic modern music is the kind that prevails. Consequently, the majority of youth know no other music than "rock", promoted and spread for many years now by numerous rock groups backed up by their many followers.

Regarding music, We state here the relevant article in Holy Palmarian Morals: "Modern music, i.e. rock and all its derivatives, and suchlike, is the work of Satan himself. By means of that music, free rein is given to all man's lower passions. Hysteria, fanaticism, drug addiction, excessive drinking and many other psychical and physical disorders are fomented. Modern music is utterly opposed to the true art of music, and is an infernal incentive to sensuality. Modern music is contrary to God's Infinite Beauty, to Sound Morals and to good taste in art. Consequently it is a grievous peril for man; and so he is obliged to avoid all co-operation with and influence from such music, and openly reject it. It is a mortal sin to have tapes or disks of that music, or to listen to it with attention. It should be born in mind that to hear is not to listen; so there is sin when, the music having been noted, it is expressly listened to." So then, beloved children, before acquiring any musical recording, you have the grave obligation of revising it thoroughly. We have always been a great lover of good music, and Our ears are used to true musical art, so that We have always felt total natural rejection for modern music. Get used to listening to good music, so that your ears likewise become attuned to good musical taste. All those who still have any disks, mobile telephones or other apparatus with music forbidden by the Church, should hand them in quickly to their Missionary Bishop to be destroyed. And anyone who still has recordings on the computer should delete them at once. We impose this duty under pain of excommunication reserved to Us. We hope that those who have been followers of satanic modern music bear forever in mind that this perversion is strictly forbidden by the Church.

We remind you yet again, chiefly young people: when you come on pilgrimage to this Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, bear very much in mind that the Apostolic See of the Church is here, and behave with due dignity. Any kind of scandal that occurs here, more than anywhere else, prejudices the good reputation which the Holy Palmarian Church should always enjoy. This Sacred Place, bastion of the Sacrosanct Catholic Faith, was chosen by God for prayer and penance, and to be the school of Holy Doctrine and Morals. Much care should therefore be taken to avoid giving any bad example here. The enemies of our Holy Work are avid to see something negative with which to discredit this Work with yet greater frenzy. We are often the object of attacks by the different communications media, and every kind of lie and calumny is told of us. Dear young people, do not by bad conduct give greater force to Satan's agents to denigrate this Blessed Place, chosen by God for the salvation of the world. Good spirits are not at odds with holy piety, nor with upright character. When you are in the village of El Palmar de Troya.





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always give testimony of the great spirit of piety and sacred order which reign within the walls where the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar is to be found, Christianity's Sacred Shrine. Be moderate with drink, so as never to let your judgement be affected. We again repeat that good spirits are not at odds with virtue, quite the contrary: holy good spirits are the patrimony of holy virtue.

Beloved Palmarian children: when you arrange a reception on the occasion of a wedding or some other event, make sure that the time used for the celebration be prudent, so that there be no likelihood of excesses, and thus avoid possible scandals. At social gatherings, Palmarians should always stand out for their decency, moderation and good taste. No vulgar uproar nor deafening commotion should be heard. Let healthy joy and moderation reign in your celebrations. If you hold your wedding reception in El Palmar de Troya or nearby, for greater reason you should always be very prudent, as any kind of disorder prejudices the Sacred Place.

We, Peter II, as Vicar of Christ, again insist that the children of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church read the Palmarian Creed and Catechism over and over again. In them is a simple and clear compendium of the Infallible Magisterium of the Church. Besides, it is a duty of Palmarian parents to give catechism classes to their children from a very early age. So that a tree grow upright and sturdy, it has to be tended from the first moment. No Palmarian parent can elude this weighty responsibility. A child's religious upbringing should begin gradually from life's first moments. The pious things children learn when very small usually stay in their minds all their lives.

Beloved faithful: sate your longings for wisdom as well in Sacred History or the Holy Palmarian Bible, which for you should be the Book *par excellence*, inseparable companion and good counsellor. No day should pass without reading some passage from the Bible, above all the Holy Gospel. Meditate often on the Moral Books of the Old Testament (Proverbs, Wisdom, Ecclesiastes, Ecclesiasticus, etc.). In them you will find sage counsels for you to lead your lives along the paths of righteousness. Do not leave out of mind the New Testament Apostolic Letters; nor the Book of the Apocalypse, in which events of the Apocalyptic Times we live in are explained with clarity and wealth of detail. You also have other Palmarian publications, such as the Documents of Pope Saint Gregory XVII and the Treatise on the Mass, sublime works of colossal and incalculable doctrinal value. In short, beloved children, you are highly privileged. You have the means to attain high degrees of heavenly wisdom. You are in possession of the incomparable doctrinal wealth reserved by God for the children of the Church in the Last Times. Always show your gratitude to the Most High for the abundance you receive from His Benevolent Hands.

May the Most Holy Virgin Mary, Our Mother, Queen and Lady, guide you as Divine Shepherdess and teach you as Divine Doctress. Always turn to Her with full trust in Her Perpetual Succour. Love Her dearly, to folly, for our Divine Mother always attends those who call upon Her earnestly. She never forsakes the child who is faithful to Her. We know this from Our own experience.

The Palmarian Holy Week programme for 2008 will have the following daily timetable of worship: At 1 am there will be a turn of Holy Masses on the Main Altar and other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Penitential Rosary; at 10 am, the Most Solemn Pontifical, with the recital of the Holy Trisagion; at 6 pm, a turn of Holy Masses on the Main Altar as well as on the other Altars, with the recital of the Holy Way of the Cross; at 9 pm, the corresponding Procession. Besides, there will be turns of Masses along





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with Penitential Rosaries day and night. The Cathedral-Basilica of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, except for brief intervals, will remain open day and night throughout Holy Week.






Concerning Spanish Unity, the Castilian Language and the true exercise of power

We, Peter II, Sovereign Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of Palmar de Troya, *de Cruce Apocalýptica*, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

Most beloved Palmarian children: Our heart is inundated with joy each time We address you. We ask of God to illuminate Us, and that Our poor teaching penetrate and become established in your souls with deep and solid roots, so that copious spiritual fruits be produced to your benefit and that of all humanity. In view of the forthcoming 16th of July, Principal Feast of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, Queen of Carmel and Universal Patroness, We, Pope Peter II, again call all the faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church to come on pilgrimage to the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, thus to participate in the Most Solemn Worship. Our Heavenly Mother awaits you all, Palmarian faithful, and She well deserves that you respond with love to Her ardent desires. Endeavour to honour Her by your presence, without sparing efforts, and show Her once more your gratitude for the untold graces you constantly receive from Her Most Blessed Hands.

Very dear children, united in fraternal charity, diligently prepare the Pilgrimage for the Feast of Carmel corresponding to Palmarian Holy Year 2008. Cooperate with one another in love and generosity. As members you are of the Mystical Body of Christ, you form the true family of the sons of God on earth, by means of supernatural ties, incomparably superior to natural blood ties. You must, therefore, remain ever united through the virtue of charity, so that true peace and harmony reign among you, since you are working for the propagation of God's Kingdom, which is the most just and holy of causes. As members of the Mystical Body, you thus form a most beautiful spiritual cluster, vitalized by the Blood of Christ and Mary, and divinized by the vivifying action of the Holy Ghost, Who is the Uncreated Soul of the Church. By means of the presence in your souls of supernatural charity you are espoused one with another by virtue of your espousal with the Divinity. Saint Paul, in his letter to the Colossians, says in this respect:





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
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"Attire yourselves in the virtue of charity which is the bond of perfect union one with another and of all with God."

Most beloved children of Our Papal Heart: We again repeat, and with ever greater insistence: You are called to sanctity, and therefore obliged to co-operate with the grace of God so that the edifice of your sanctification be ever more solid, elevated and valuable. This labour exacts constancy in the exercise of virtues, a heroic detachment, and a ceaseless struggle against the soul's enemies. You must work hard, then, for the grace of sanctity, as valorous apostles, as hardened soldiers, without giving in before obstacles, without ever admitting defeat, without being discouraged in the face of personal weakness and possible falls. With constancy you will attain perseverance and with perseverance the final triumph. O most beloved children, many begin well and then desert in view of setbacks, preferring the spacious way of perdition instead of continuing along the narrow path that leads to eternal life. The Kingdom of Heaven is only for those who strive. Christ opened the doors of His Kingdom to us by means of His Sacrosanct Passion and Death, thus showing us that it is the way of sorrow that leads to eternal salvation. Remember what He Himself said: "Whoever does not take up his cross and follow Me is not worthy of Me. Whoever, at the cost of losing his soul keeps his life, will lose eternal life; and whoever loses his life for love of Me, shall find it again in Heaven."

See, dearly beloved children, you are bearers of the Palmarian Catholic Faith, a most precious gift you should not make subject to conditions. Those who conditioned their faith to the fulfilment or otherwise of future events, sooner or later gave up. The Faith must be lived authentically. By Faith, we firmly believe what God has revealed and what the Church teaches us. And as Faith is firmly to believe what we cannot see, it exacts of men great humility of understanding and heart. We personally knew some of the earlier followers of the Apparitions of El Palmar de Troya who, in spite of the many proofs received in favour of the truth, had the audacity to say they would withdraw from the Apparitions if things announced in the Heavenly Messages were not fulfilled soon. And of course they withdrew, losing all the graces, despite the fulfilment of many messages, but not as they wished according to their comfortable and arbitrary convictions. Others who prayed and led the prayers at the Lentisco in the foremost line, also withdrew for similar reasons. Many as well apostatized from the Palmarian Church for being unwilling to comply with Her dispositions. And We ask: Who is man, miserable creature, to exact anything of Almighty God, our Creator?

Most beloved children: Of the many Marian Apparitions of these Last Times, only those of El Palmar de Troya prevail. And why did the others succumb? Simply because they were not faithful to the messages received, and as well because they rejected the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, elected by the mysterious designs of God as light, guide and centre of all other places of apparitions and as Apostolic See of the Church. And as events clearly demonstrate, the plans of Our Lord God through the different Apparitions of the Most Holy Virgin Mary have been fulfilled up till now in the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya, and will continue to be fulfilled if we remain steadfast to the graces. Our Heavenly Mother, as Precursoress of the Glorious Second Coming of Christ, denounced by word of mouth and with clarity the corruption existing in the roman church and her consequent apostasy, and prepared the way so that all Her faithful children might assemble in the Mystical Desert of El Palmar de Troya, the one fold of salvation.

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Therefore, Our Lord Jesus Christ designated this Most Blessed Place of El Palmar as the new throne for the Chair of Saint Peter, following the death of the glorious Pope Saint Paul VI, electing directly as Supreme Pontiff Our Revered Predecessor, Pope Saint Gregory XVII the Very Great, who transferred the Apostolic See of the Church from Rome to El Palmar de Troya. So, dear faithful, only those who are within the sheepfold of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, now ruled by Us, Pope Peter II, are bearers of truth, those who possess in their souls, through grace, the Kingdom of God possible on earth, and the legitimate heirs of the Heavenly Homeland or Eternal Kingdom. O most beloved children: live your faith with rectitude, but live it as well with complete confidence that Our Lord God is ever faithful to His promises for those who love and serve Him loyally. Still, you must bear well in mind that God's mysteries are inscrutable, and His plans are being fulfilled as He has decreed eternally, and not as man imagines. By your good works, you make yourselves worthier of the fulfilment of the divine promises.

Most beloved children of Our Priestly Heart: We say to you in the words of Saint Paul: "Ever use your liberty without prejudice to the holy Law of God and the good conduct you should always observe as members you are of the Church." Those who make bad use of their liberty deny God the worship due to Him, and become adorers of themselves and of the things they illicitly love. Never forget that the principal cause of sin is egolatry, which is disorderly love of our own esteem. By that sin of pride, man constitutes himself an idol or false god, with the intention of adoring himself and of being adored by others. In turn, by using creatures contrary to that established in the Law of God, man makes false gods or idols of them, adoring them by his sins and therefore turning himself into an idolater. In short, he denies God the homage of adoration that corresponds to Him alone, so as to render it to Satan himself. O most beloved children: By divine leave and owing to general corruption, the world is a temple of iniquity, where egolatry and idolatry run rampant. Altars in honour of heresy and vice, in short in honour of Satan, father of sin, invade everything, and everywhere the most brazen licentiousness prevails.

Observe, most beloved children, present day society promotes egolatrous homage in multiple ways. One of these is the proliferation of gymnasiums, where many people of different ages devote themselves to exercises, inordinately eager to endow their bodies with prominent musculature and other unnecessary peculiarities, and in their greater part for presumptuous and worldly ends. This licentious body-building is clearly "body worship." We have been informed that some Palmarian faithful frequent public gymnasiums, which is contrary to the dispositions of the Holy Palmarian Church, as these places are similar to beaches and swimming pools, for the environment that is scandalous in great part. Therefore, Palmarian faithful are not permitted to enter gymnasiums under any pretext, whether they are solely for men or solely for women, and this prohibition is under pain of excommunication reserved to the confessor.

We do not oppose men and women seeking to improve their physical condition, even though it be only for aesthetic reasons, but always with appropriate prudence and without transgressing the Law of God and the dispositions of the Church. So, Palmarians can practise gymnastics, but always fulfilling the norms of Christian decency. If for health reasons someone has to attend a rehabilitation centre, they should inform themselves thoroughly beforehand whether that centre complies with the conditions exacted by Holy Palmarian Morals; since to the contrary one cannot assist, as health of soul far surpasses corporal health. Regarding the obligatory gymnastic classes that may be required of pupils at schools and colleges,





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
if Palmarians cannot manage to exempt themselves, they may assist, but always correctly dressed, and only if the hall and the gymnastic exercises do not oppose the norms of Holy Church. We consider that, with what has been said, the matter has been made sufficiently clear.

We, Pope Peter II, deem it most opportune to recall again that many years ago the Holy Palmarian Church condemned boxing and wrestling, which involve a brutal assault on the life or physical or psychical integrity of man, and is abominable in the eyes of God. Therefore, a person incurs excommunication reserved to the Pope if he participates in boxing or wrestling, or cooperates in any way with these spectacles, or witnesses them in any form, directly in the place of the spectacle or on television, or listens to them on the radio. Later Holy Church made the anterior disposition clearer by establishing that a person incurs excommunication reserved to the Pope if he sees, hears or reads anything to do with boxing, wrestling, martial arts, karate, judo, yoga, fencing and other similar things. Therefore it is totally forbidden for Palmarian faithful to practise these activities or collaborate with them in any way. Most beloved children, be concerned more with spiritually strengthening and enriching yourselves. The main thing is to cultivate the soul through the exercise of virtue. On this greatest treasure you should set your ambitions. Do not set your sights in an exaggerated way on things that concern the body, which is dust and will return to dust. This does not mean that bodily health should be neglected, as it is a duty of man to look after his body as well, and whoever rashly abuses his health sins grievously. See what the Holy Ghost says in the Book of Ecclesiasticus: "Bodily health, accompanied by holiness and virtue of soul, is preferable to all gold and silver."

Concerning care and adornment of the body, Holy Palmarian Morals teach that feminine adornment is good, proper, including desirable when discreet. The first thing that a woman should seek is to adorn herself with the spiritual jewellery of the Christian virtues. But it is also very wholesome and quite proper in women to be discreetly adorned. Women can dress and care for their appearance with taste, and use make-up discreetly in order to enhance their beauty; but this must be without breaking the norms of Christian modesty. This means they should do so in order to emphasize femininity in a Christian way, but not out of vainglory, or ostentation, much less out of sensuality; for the single woman who aspires to marriage naturally endeavours to beautify herself as best she can with the intention that some honourable man more easily take notice of her; and the same applies to a married woman with the intention of pleasing her husband, although Christian spouses should love each other not only for outward qualities, but above all for the virtues in their souls. So, Palmarian women cannot imitate pernicious and scandalous worldly fashions. With regard to men, they should dress with discretion too and with masculinity; that is, they should care for their appearance in accord with their sex.

We, Pope Peter II, with anguished concern and sorrow, see each day that masonic plans, on a universal scale, ever meet with greater acceptance, with the perverse aim of tearing up from society even the roots of whatever sound morality might still prevail. It's a question of an iniquitous despoiling, completely opposed to Divine Law and Natural Law. Today, hypocritically, they preach in favour of human rights, and at the same time deliberately contravene those rights. A very palpable example is the practice of criminal abortion permitted by laws, which contravenes the right to life. The murder of children yet unborn cries to Heaven and brings the Holy Wrath of God down upon those who authorize these crimes, those who practise them and those who collaborate in any way. Another also very palpable example is the





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
legalization of marriages between homosexuals, an aberrant concubinage which contravenes the very essence of true marriage instituted by God for union between man and woman with the principal end of human procreation. And what is to be said of massive, accursed divorces; and of marriages between divorced people, which lack all validity; since however many laws legalize them, they are and always will be aberrant concubinage opposed to the essence of true marriage; since validly contracted marriage between man and woman is indissoluble, and only at the death of one of the spouses does the other become free to marry again, if the person so desires. Besides the above examples, there are many others, but it would be interminable to list them here. Present day society is morally chaotic. Society is ruled by pagan governments whose aim is to banish every idea of God from man, so that he submit to pagan ideologies and corrupt morality promoted at state level by way of iniquitous laws.

And We, what shall We say of state educational plans in schools, colleges and universities? The satanic plan is ever more alarming. The idea is to deprive children of their innocence at the most tender age, under the devious pretext of preparing and forming them for the future by means of classes of sexual orientation and other subjects opposed to truth; and thus nothing sound be left in society, not even the innocence of children. With similar procedures, they foment unchastity and instil aberrant political and social doctrine in youth. The aim is to inculcate in minds, at all costs, political liberalism and social laicism, so that children, youths, adults and elderly absorb the same erroneous ideas and ruinous plans of those who rule the destinies of the nations. The question is one of establishing licentiousness with its multiplicity of variants and shades, so that all think and act in accord with preconceived masonic plans. In a word, it is a question of trampling underfoot God's authority and His legitimate rights in governing the world, as Creator and Lord He is of all things.

We, Pope Peter II, by the Supreme Authority with which We are invested, anathematize all teaching systems opposed to the true Catholic Doctrine taught by Our Revered Predecessors the Popes, and taught by Us, Peter II, present day Sovereign Pontiff of the Church. We, as Vicar of Christ, require of all faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church: to be always very much on the alert, and not to let yourselves be deceived by current perverse doctrines, whether religious, political or social in character, imposed by freemasonry by means of many of its henchmen who direct the destinies of the nations. Always be very much on the alert, most beloved children, because Satan, by divine leave, is extending ever farther his ensnaring and devouring schemes.

O most beloved children: In the times we live in, they wax lyrical about the democratic social and political system. Under cover of democracy unspeakable blunders are committed all over the world. An example we have in Spain, a real Tower of Babel, where neither governors nor citizens understand each other. Territorial dismemberment, ever more marked, is an evident fact. Previously, the delightful regions of Spain, with their multiple and rich variations, consolidated the unity of an enviable Homeland, pious, cultured, prosperous, robust and powerful. But today, because of democracy, accursed separatism tears to shreds the standard of a glorious past. The noble Spanish People, erstwhile head of many nations, is now reduced to the most pitiable indigence, not only in the religious and moral orders, but in the cultural, economic, political and social as well. Politicians attempt to put Spain to rights by dismembering her more and more. At present in Spain the most perverse laicism reigns, and the Law of God is supplanted by state laws that exclude all divine moral order, both natural and supernatural. On the other hand, the Castilian





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Language, so rich and varied in words, is despised by many who detest being Spaniards, and would banish it from the Homeland if they could. Consider, the very rich Castilian Language, the Spanish Language, spread throughout the world, spoken by many millions of people, has given much glory to the Church and to the Homeland. How shameful, all this linguistic division in Spain! This division, considered by many as a blessing, an advance, cultural progress, is nevertheless a chastisement: that of the confusion of tongues, that of separatism, of impoverishment and disintegration of the Homeland. So precise, so sweet and so much poetry in the Castilian Language! It has always been said by great intellectuals that Spanish is for speaking with God. And it is true. Thus, dearly beloved Palmarians, those who still do not know the Castilian Language, learn it with love, and you will penetrate into the profundity of its richness.


Most beloved Palmarian children: it is Catholic and infallible doctrine that authority or true temporal power is that which comes only from God and is given by Him to man so that he represent Him and take God's place in the divine plan of order and universal government. That is only possible within the true Church; since no one can represent the power and authority of God if not subject as a Church member to the sacred authority of the Pope. In authority as instituted by God, temporal power resides only in the one person who holds it in the name of God. Thus the Head of State conserves full power to dictate and promulgate laws, to ordain their execution and fulfilment, and to administer justice; although it is most convenient that for the purpose he make use of state organs formed by upright people, prudent and expert, for them to represent and assist him in his difficult task; but that his authority never be supplanted by them. Totally opposed to the exercise of genuine power is democracy: a perverse system that radically opposes Divine Law, and therefore true spiritual, social, political, cultural and economic values. Democracy is a political system based on the error that authority or power resides in the people, so that laws and other governmental functions are subjected to the will of the majority, without the Head of State having decisive power, as his own political system obliges him to respect and admit all that the people decide through Parliament, whether it be just or unjust, morally good or morally evil, which implies a tremendous aberration.

And nothing more for now, most beloved children. Faithful Palmarians, come all to the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya for the Feast of Carmel of the year 2008!


We, Peter II, Sovereign Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Servant of the servants of God, Patriarch of Palmar de Troya, de Cruce Apocalyptica, Herald of the Lord God of Hosts, Aflame with the Zeal of Elias.

We, by means of the present Apostolic Letter, call all the faithful of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, to come on pilgrimage to the Cathedral-Basilica of the Apostolic See, on occasion of the Most Solemn Worship of the 12th of October in the year 2008, Principal Feast of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar, Illuminatrix of the Holy Palmarian Council and of the Holy Palmarian Synod.

Most beloved children of Our Papal Heart: We deem it very necessary and beneficial for your souls to remind you again that gratitude to Our Lord God is an ineluctable duty of children of the Church. In the episode recounted in the Holy Gospel where ten lepers were cured, Christ Himself lamented that only one of them returned to show gratitude for his bodily cure. And if Our Divine Saviour expressed, through a sublime complaint, His profound sadness at the discourtesy of nine of the lepers, with greater reason will He feel in His Most Divine Soul the discourtesy by those of His children who do not duly appreciate the supernatural graces received for their salvation and greater sanctification. The Deific Heart of Jesus, which loves men so dearly, requires of Palmarians a response to love in the greatest possible degree. Christ is the jealous Lover who seeks in the hearts of His faithful children thoughtfulness and atonement for the offences He continually receives. And the way to make amends is with love, demonstrated in the fulfilment of duties towards God and the Church, which necessarily exacts the fulfilment of other holy duties, like, for example, family and work obligations.

O most beloved children! Serving Christ is to reign. So that we may reign with Christ, He became obedient for us unto death and death on the Cross. For our good, Christ came into this world to serve us, and as a servant to fulfil the will of the Eternal Father. He died on the Cross for us, which is the greatest





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
proof of service on our behalf. And if Christ became a humble servant, we must follow His footsteps serving God with maximum generosity and our neighbour for the love of God. Service to God and our neighbour is the basis of our spiritual reign in this world and, above all, of our eternal reign through contemplation of God in Heaven forever and ever. See, dear children, whoever serves Christ faithfully is a powerful king by the dominion he acquires over the demon, the world, and his own concupiscent appetites. In holy servitude resides the dominion of man over sin. Through Sanctifying Grace, as servants, we are raised to the rank of children of God, and by means of this divine filiation we are endowed with royalty as children of the Divine King and heirs of an Eternal Kingdom. How consoling and edifying is this truth! Royalty resides, then, in the fulfilment of God's will, as is clearly evident in the parable of the ten minas, where the Lord says to one of His faithful servants: "Excellent, my good servant; because you have been faithful in a little, I will give you authority over ten cities." About the eternal reign of those who are saved, the Treatise of the Mass says: "Each human person will be king of his own kingdom; and at the same time will form part of the empire of Heaven, governed with utmost wisdom by the Most Divine Supreme Emperor, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and the August Divine Empress, the Most Holy Virgin Mary."

Most beloved Palmarian children: keep yourselves always in perfect servitude. Be the faithful servants of Our Lord God and of His Holy Church. You are called to reign eternally with Christ, in a kingdom without end, in a kingdom of peace, in a kingdom of sanctity. The Divine and Supreme Judge, Christ Jesus, will come one day, perhaps when you least expect, to measure and value the fruits of the talents each one of you has been given as administrators. In that decisive moment, the disloyal will have no excuse. They, if they do not repent, can only expect the words of the Lord to the unfaithful servant in the parable: "Wicked servant, by your own lips I condemn you." Look, the graces God pours out over the children of the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church in these Last Times are a constant deluge. The privilege of belonging to the true Church of Christ, in this age of general apostasy, is so extraordinary that human intelligence is incapable of evaluating it adequately. Is it not already great and astonishing before the world, that the true Church of Christ is today made up of an insignificant number of militant faithful and confined to the desert of El Palmar de Troya? Is it not great and astonishing as well that the true Vicar of Christ, We, Peter II, Supreme Authority in Spiritual and Temporal Orders appears in the world in unaccustomed poverty and simplicity? These Apocalyptic Times of the Church are only comparable to the first times of Christianity, in which the Barque of Peter found itself reduced to catacombs, amid paganism and apostasy.

Most beloved Palmarian children, you are greatly favoured! You must therefore apply yourselves more and more to persevering in the Catholic Faith. Only with holy perseverance will you become worthy of Eternal Blessedness, where you will reign with Christ in an everlasting kingdom of utter happiness. Sadly, in these transcendental and glorious moments of the Church in the Mystical Desert of El Palmar de Troya, so many Palmarians who were among the first, have separated from the true sheepfold for the sake of human expediency! Consider, most beloved children, if there can exist harmony of any kind between the Catholic Faith and the things of the world opposed to it. There cannot! No harmony whatsoever is possible! Either with Christ or with Satan, there is no middle course. We again remind you of the following words of Christ: "Whoever, after putting his hand to the plough, turns to look back, is not worthy of the Kingdom of Heaven."

So much persecution of the Work of El Palmar de Troya! We, who know of this from its beginnings, are witness to the defaming lies uttered against this Divine Work, whose only mission is to save the world. So many calumnies against the Holy Palmarian Church and its Religious Order of Carmelites of the Holy Face! And the greatest pity is that, many times the persecution is instigated by vindictive Palmarians who have apostatized. So much diabolical fury, so much poison by way of journalism, radio and television! And





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


why this obstinate persecution? Simply because Palmarian doctrine and discipline is totally incompatible with the heresies and corruptions of the world. In the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian Church, there is no place for dispositions opposed to Truth, or ambiguous postures. Within the true Church only authenticity is admissible. But you, most beloved Palmarian children, ever respond to our persecutors with prayer and sacrifice. Christ Himself teaches us: "Pray for those who persecute and calumniate you." Reflect, most beloved children, many of those who condemned and denigrated our Holy Work have since died and been judged by the Supreme and Unappealable Judge. We desire wholeheartedly that they rectified at Particular Judgment and attained divine mercy. The Palmarian Church, nonetheless, continues upright, and maintains herself alive and vigorous. It is the Work of God, and no one can get the better of Her; for whoever dares to combat Her will be fighting against the Supreme Maker, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and against His Most Holy Mother the Virgin Mary; and, "Who is like unto God? No one is like unto God!" Let all those who combat the Holy Work of El Palmar tremble! Always bear very much in mind the words of Christ: "Do you think that God will not give justice to His elect who cry out to Him day and night, and that He will leave their pleas unattended for long? I tell you that He will promptly give them justice."

Most beloved children of Our Papal Heart: wherever Peter is, there is the Church; and the mission of the Church is one of eternal life, not of death. These words should serve to strengthen your Palmarian Faith further. Peter's Cathedra is now in El Palmar de Troya, and wherever the Vicar of Christ is, there also is the Church of her Divine Founder, Whom Peter represents. Of this there is no doubt. The mission of the Church of Christ is to give eternal life to souls so that they attain eternal salvation. The mission of the Church, then, is a mission of life. Outside the true Church only death reigns and salvation is not possible. Whether they like it or not, in order to find salvation, those very obstinate in error and vice must necessarily submit to the authority of the Church, today the One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic and Palmarian, ruled by Us, Peter II, lawful representative of Christ on earth. Observe, most beloved children, pride and self-love are the greatest enemies of eternal salvation, since they beget disobedience to God and rebellion against His Divine Precepts. Many of those outside the Church know for certain that the truth resides in the Palmarian Church. The tree is known by its fruit; and, within sight of those who want to see, the supernatural fruits of the Holy Work of El Palmar are evident. Those who are aware of this are many, more than you might think, but they have no wish to admit it so as not to break with worldly commitments or find themselves subject to the holy doctrinal and disciplinary requirements of Holy Palmarian Church.

We again repeat: many are those who acknowledge the truth of El Palmar, yet do not venture to take the final step in order to avoid commitments. Truth always entails some responsibilities. If Christ had preached an undemanding Gospel, He would not have remained practically alone at the end, neither would He have been crucified by the Jewish people. But Christ preached a doctrine of Charity that, as such, is brimful of obligations towards God and our neighbour. Our Lord Jesus Christ became obedient for us unto death and death on the cross. There is no other way than that marked out by Christ: the way of renouncement and submission to the plans of His Heavenly Father. Consider, most beloved children: the Beacon of El Palmar, resplendent and inextinguishable, emits its Light through the true Catholic Doctrine and Holy Discipline, which remain alive in the true Church: the Palmarian. Who can deny this truth? Let the very obstinate compare the Divine Tree of El Palmar, Tree of Salvation, Tree of Life, with the trees of multiple apostate churches, trees of damnation, trees of death, that endeavour by their heresies and corruption to overshadow the lushness of the vigorous tree of the true Church of Christ, outside of which salvation is not possible.





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
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O most beloved Palmarian children! Taste the wholesome and delightful fruits of the Tree of Life. Nourish yourselves with the rich delicacies of Holy Wisdom contained in the foliage of its branches. Indulge yourselves with invigorating nectars that give supernatural life and lead to Eternal Blessedness. Ah! Most beloved children: all is at your disposal. Make the most of it without losing time. The way is short and there is no time to lose. Live ever for God, always for God! And courageously separate yourselves from all that opposes your salvation. Remember what the Lord says: "For what shall it profit a man if he gain the whole world and then suffer the loss of his soul? And once lost, for what shall he ransom it in exchange?" O most beloved children, you have at your disposal Holy Mass and the Holy Sacraments in order to attain divine mercy. Never live in mortal sin, most beloved children. Come quickly to the Sacrament of Confession in order to regain Sanctifying Grace if unfortunately you sin mortally. We are all weak, very weak! But by the grace of God we can be strong and powerful. Contemplate, the Confessional is the loving and merciful lap of the Eternal Father for those who go to receive the Sacrament of Penance with the required dispositions. In the Confessional, by virtue of the infinite merits of Christ and Mary, Our Heavenly Father opens His arms and embraces in His Most Paternal Heart the truly contrite and repentant. Love and value the Sacrament of Confession. And also when you incur any excommunication reserved to Us, come quickly to the papal tribunal. We desire to absolve you as soon as possible of the infraction committed. Always come with full confidence and sincerity. We observe with great anguish that some Palmarian faithful are not wholly sincere when declaring their excommunications. And still more pitiful: there have even been some cases of lying to Us, hiding the truth, and later going sacrilegiously to Sacred Worship to receive the Holy Eucharist without the least scruple. How terrible, most beloved children!. And if someone should die at the moment of committing such an abominable sacrilege? May God forbid! Look, to offend God generally there is no shyness at all. So often mortal sin is committed with the greatest impudence! And yet, so much sense of shame, so much pride and human respect at times in confessing the offence before God's tribunal!

Note, in the Acts of the Apostles of the Holy Palmarian Bible, you will find the episode of the Christian couple Ananias and his wife Saphira, who for having lied to Pope Saint Peter were ipso facto exterminated by God. Read the biblical passage with attention. Lying to the Pope and to the Church, is lying to the selfsame Holy Ghost; and this sin, by its extreme seriousness, brings down the Holy Wrath of God. How can anyone who considers himself an authentic Palmarian faithful possibly make use of falsity in order to escape with impunity from his sins and excommunications, and even accuse the Hierarchy of the Church itself of lying, Hierarchy which ardently desires to reconcile him to God? What dispositions are those? If that Palmarian faithful is not prepared to be sincere and admit his faults, it is preferable that he decide to abandon the Church, leave Her in peace, follow the way he please and not continue committing sacrileges by his presence at Sacred Worship and unworthy and scandalous reception of the Holy Sacraments. If a Palmarian faithful is not submissive to the authority of the Church or obedient to Her dispositions, his prayers are of no use, however many and long they may be, as Christ Himself teaches: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord!' shall enter the Kingdom of Heaven; but whoever does the will of My Father who is in Heaven, such shall enter the Kingdom of Heaven."

It is well to remind you, most beloved children, that all those things a Palmarian faithful is forbidden to have, being contrary to the Church's dispositions, must not be given to anyone, under any circumstance, whether Palmarian or not. That is to say, you may not give as a present or sell or transfer in any way, for example: clothing, books, music disks, films or other objects that go against the norms of the Church. Whoever does this sins grievously by scandal and incurs excommunication reserved to Us, since he hands over objects which are sinful as well for those who receive them, and therefore contributes in this way to






SANTA SEDE APOSTÓLICA EL PALMAR DE TROYA

PATRIARCADO DEL PALMAR DE TROYA ORDEN DE LOS CARMELITAS DE LA SANTA FAZ

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
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their distribution. All that is prohibited by the Church <u>must necessarily</u> be destroyed. Whatever is forbidden to a Palmarian is also forbidden to all others. This you should always bear in mind, since in addition it is unquestionable logic. We also remind you that, when a Palmarian goes outside his house into a terrain of his annexed to and not separated from the house, like for example the garden, he is obliged to keep the norms of dress as if he were in the street; except when that terrain or garden is completely enclosed or fenced in and can only be accessed by an entrance protected by a securely locked gate.

Most beloved children: by the help of grace and your own response, always live a well-ordered life. True order in the world has its basis in the personal co-operation of each individual. The basis of true order in the family is in the orderly life of each of its members. The basis of true social order depends on order in family life. The basis of true order in state and political life depends on the order that exists in society. The more orderly the individuals, the family and society, the greater the order in the world. And order necessarily implies an individual commitment, without which a collective commitment is not possible. And commitment entails efficacious co-operation with divine plans concerning order in the universe. This co-operation, in accord with God's decrees, is only truly authentic when it respects His Supreme Authority as Provident Creator, through fulfilment of the Divine Commandments. Further, in order to co-operate holy and efficaciously in God's plans for order in the world, man must also be submissive and obedient to the Commandments of the Church and the dispositions of the Pope, her Supreme Pastor, and therefore a member of the true Church, to which Christ entrusted the mission of directing men to true supernatural and natural order.

Our Lord God, as Supreme Ordainer, created everything in perfect order, and until the sin of Adam and Eve the most consummate order reigned in the Universe. Then, through original sin, the existing order was altered very considerably. Although the Sacrifice of Calvary is restoring in part the graces lost by the sin of our first parents, and restoring in part the Universe perturbed by the sin of both, yet disorder remains and in addition grows in the measure that the corruption of mankind increases. Only at the arrival of the Messianic Kingdom will the Universe be completely restored in the spiritual and material orders. In the Last Times we are living through, disorder is an epidemic on a Universal scale which affects every sphere. Religious, moral, cultural, economic, social and political chaos has risen to unacceptable levels. Men turn their backs on God and impudently mock His Holy Law. Now some, now others, with pretentious and godless ends, try to establish order to their liking, to the measure of their interests, to the measure of their licentiousness, dispensing with God, the Church and true charity towards neighbour. The most powerful nations squander their wealth in armaments and unjust wars, in abuses that call down the Holy Wrath of God, and ever with monopolizing plans, without giving importance to the indigence of other peoples, or the elevated human death toll. So much genocide promoted by iniquitous interests. So many men guilty of genocide live in impunity without anyone daring to call them to order, without anyone throwing their crimes in their face. That is how the world is today, most beloved children; and We do not exaggerate, as the evidence is undeniable. This is the everyday news which We bear with indescribable affliction and anguish. So many crimes, and at the same time so much hypocrisy, endless comings and goings, so much fuss and commotion, so many meetings on an international scale that are completely useless. Aye! That masonic UNO and its so-called Security Council, that masonic European Community and its Parliament! So much pride and injustice! And as the fire of charity required by Christ does not burn in the world, the raging fire of divine justice will soon burn. When the Holy Wrath of God is implacably unleashed, the world will be seen to be enveloped in flames and everything will be purified amid lamentations and horrifying screams. Then will many of the proud admit that it was madness to rebel against their Creator. O perverse world dominators! They try to justify their iniquitous wars alleging they are to defend what they call "liberties," but





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
which are nothing other than libertinage; and thus, by means of unjust wars and countless death-tolls, take advantage of them to exploit the peoples and enslave them under their power.


Oh, most beloved children. Consider the tension between the two giant colossuses: the United States and Russia. The United States endeavours to continue governing and dominating the world at her good pleasure, and in the measure of her ambitious interests, and Russia is not prepared to permit it, because it affects her ambitious interests as well. Furthermore, Russia and China united will be the executioner of the United States and of other many nations who presume to be powerful, especially in Europe, however gigantic and powerful the group that composes the European Community may be. For their direct relationship with world events, We remind you of some messages given in the Sacred Place of El Palmar de Troya many years ago, to Clemente Domínguez y Gómez, now Pope Saint Gregory XVII the Very Great. The Most Holy Virgin Mary: "Aye! United States of America: you will be destroyed by your eagerness for power and exploitation of mankind! For your pride, vanity, arrogance and shameless wealth, you will be annihilated. Russia, be converted! Russia, be converted! Russia, be converted! It is not too late! Your conversion will come through My Immaculate Heart. Russia will again be the scourge of humanity, and afterwards will be converted." Our Lord Jesus Christ: "Observe communist China very closely: she is arming to the teeth. Secretly she is fabricating devices capable of destroying mankind. The world is misled about atomic advances in China. Beware of China, beware! All precautions are few. China is ready to do battle against the most powerful enemies. China can swipe with her claws at any moment. Fix your gaze on Russia: she is prepared to launch a terrible attack. Her devices are ready to explode at any moment. Observe the great giant of the United States: she is ready to give a decisive battle. And the three will do so in a selfish way. None of the three great powers has good intentions. China too, like Russia and the United States, seek only to seize the whole world, and silence the voices of small countries." For example, the United States Nation, whose arsenals are tightly packed with atomic weapons of a refined destructive effect, has the effrontery to forbid other countries to make their own armaments, so that she be the dominator of the world; and to this end is backed up by her satellites, who are countries obedient and submissive to her ambitious plans. The panorama opening up in the present-day world is frightening and blood-curdling. In the Third World War many cities, including entire nations, will disappear from the face of the earth. Let the world prepare for the great cataclysm. All that we are now seeing: continuous wars, revolutions, uprisings, disintegrations, economic chaos, and the like, are signs which evidence the imminent final atomic explosion of World War III.

Most beloved children: no nation, however powerful and influential she may be, can declare war on another without a just cause. In this respect, we cite here the doctrine of Holy Palmarian Morals, which is the Catholic doctrine always taught by the Church: war is the struggle between two or more nations in order to make their rights prevail, or to restore them once infringed. So that a declaration of war be lawful, legitimate authority, just cause and upright intention are required. War can be resorted to only after exhausting all pacific measures: diplomatic negotiations, arbitration of a neutral nation, etc. War without a just cause is a most grievous sin of whoever provokes it. Of course, the use of weapons of war in defence of the rights of God and of the Church; is a just war; and also in defence of Country when faced with unjust invasion by an enemy, as well as for other just causes. Still, the duty to defend Country obliges only in all that is not against God and Holy Mother Church.

Most beloved children: We give you heartfelt thanks for the warm and affectionate reception given to Us, during Our visit to the Palmarian Chapel in Unterschwandorf, Germany, on the 22nd of last May, on the occasion of the solemnity of Corpus Christi, and as well, during Our visit to the Palmarian Chapel in Dublin,







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Ireland, on Sunday the 15th of last June. To both came numerous faithful, giving most faithful and cordial testimony of full adhesion to Us, Peter II, as Vicar of Christ that We are by His infinite mercy. Thank you, most dear children, many thanks! During this journey of prayer and reparation to God, from the 14th of May to the 19th of June in the year 2008 through Europe, We, by divine impulse, visited Russia in the Month of May. On the 27th and 28th, We celebrated Holy Masses in city of Saint Petersburg, and on the 29th, 30th and 31st, We celebrated Holy Masses in the capital Moscow. In Moscow, on the 31st of May, We also made the consecration of Russia to the Holy Face, to Our Crowned Mother of Palmar and to Most Holy Crowned Saint Joseph of Palmar, to be seech the Eternal Father the prompt conversion of the Russian people. This first visit of Ours to Russia, as Pope, is of supreme importance and transcendence. It is a world event of the greatest importance! The sandals of the Supreme Fisher of Men on earth, trod the streets of and toured the two most emblematic cities of the Russian nation. We celebrated the Holy Masses with indescribable emotion. We ardently desire that the Russian people, through their prompt conversion, acknowledge Our Supreme Authority, and come to swell the ranks of the Holy Palmarian Church, only bearer of the Saving Truth. We desire the greatest good for the Russian people: her prompt conversion. We are aware of the very many errors of this nation and her unremitting marxist-imperialist plans. Yet We desire, and hope, that she return to God through sincere conversion. You also, Palmarian children, beseech that Our most vehement desire be granted without delay. In the end Russia will be converted! Have complete assurance and confidence in the promise of the Mother of God.

Most beloved Palmarian children: turn always and in all confidence to the Most Holy Virgin Mary, Our Heavenly Mother, so that She guide, teach and fortify you to keep firmly on the way of sanctification. Take refuge under Mary's perpetual succour! With Her motherly protection you will go on ahead securely and will rise quickly after any fall, if unfortunately you sin. As Mother of Mercy, She always receives the children who come and supplicate before Her divine feet in their sufferings, problems and weaknesses. Christ Our Lord, in a most generous act of charity, gave us as Mother His Own Mother. Be, then, grateful to Him for such a magnanimous and loving gesture, and make the utmost use of the Virgin Mary's Most Loving Maternity. You will never be defrauded. She is most faithful towards those who invoke Her help and protection with perseverance and confidence. She is refuge of sinners. Live ever under Her maternal mantle. Turn to Saint Joseph as well in your needs. Invoke him ever with confidence.

And nothing more for now, most beloved children. The forthcoming 12th of October, God willing, the Holy Face of Jesus and the Sacred Image of Our Crowned Mother of Palmar will go out in procession. Do not forget that the 15th of October is the feast of Saint Teresa of Jesus. Procure on that day, those who can, to honour as well the Eminent Reformatrix of Carmel, and Mother too of Our Order.
